

BRIEF DISCRPTION OF DISTRICT 1 OFFICERS/COMMITTEE DUTIES

Below are the office and committee chairperson positions that will be available soon. It's an excellent opportunity for service in AA. Voting will be November 2022 at 6:30 at the Club 215 at the District meeting. New positions will commence in January 2023.

DCM (District committee member) chairs the district meetings which are held the second Tuesday of the month (except December) at the Hawkeye club at 6:30 PM. Some of the duties are: receives reports from GSR's, keeps GSR's informed of conference activities, attends the Area 24 conferences twice a year and business meetings quarterly in Marshalltown.

ALTERNATE DCM is backup for the DCM. If the DCM resigns or is unable to serve, the alternate steps in.

SECRETARY keeps all written records and writes the minutes of the district meeting.

TREASURER is responsible for all income and expenses. The treasurer will give a report each month. District 1 will be fully self-supporting.

NEWSLETTER committee chairperson prepares the publication of the District 1 newsletter.

ARCHIVES committee chairperson, maintains and preserves the District archives which include reports, fliers, minutes, etc.

PI/CPC (public information and cooperation with the professional community) The chairperson provides accurate information about AA to the public. They serve as resources to the media and offer public service announcements to radio and TV stations. They also provide information about AA to those who have contact with alcoholics through their profession.

CORRECTIONS committee chairperson brings AA into correctional facilities by arranging for individual members and groups to carry the message.

TREATMENT committee chairperson brings AA into hospitals, treatment centers and rehab centers by arranging for individual members and groups to carry the message.

LITERATURE committee chairperson informs groups and district members of all AA conference approved literature, audiovisual material, pamphlets, etc. They bring literature to AA events.

GRAPEVINE committee chairperson informs groups of all Grapevine material and encourages members to subscribe to the Grapevine, "Our meeting in print."

It is recommended that these positions be filled by members who have at least 2 years sobriety.

Any AA member is encouraged to attend District meetings. Our next meeting is September 13.
