1 Use the direction to enhance your subject

The direction of the light will make a big difference in the final image. Depending on how the sunlight is shining on your subject have by poisoning your subject you will create a completely different perspective.

- Behind the subject will produce a Halo effect around your subject
- In front of the subject you will have a soft diffusion light that highlights the details
- On Either side you will produce the shadow effect

Always beware on how the light is shining on your and use it to your advantage

2 Create depth and dimension

The most effective way to use natural light is by creating a sense of dimension to your image

By positioning your subject in relation to the source you can use shadows to take advantage of the special features of the subject and show a good contrast

The golden hours of the day will produce the best results as the light is more diffused causing a more linear shadow Have the light coming from the side for best results,

3 Find the perfect angle

By setting up the perfect angle you will get the most flattering image

In order to get the perfect angle from natural light you need to position the subject at a 45 degree angle to the light source this creates a good sense of depth and dimension by causing the shadows to go across the main surface area

Take the consideration of the height of your light source in relation to your subject as it will affect how the shadows appear.

- Too high will cause shadows under the eyes and nose
- Too low will cause shadows on the chin and neck
