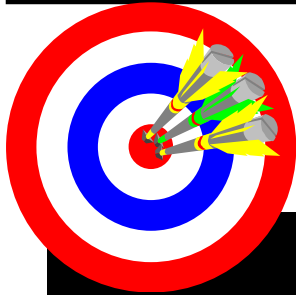

The state outdoor will be held on August 7th and 8th in Aberdeen, with a shotgun start for both days. A registration form for this tournament can be found elsewhere in this newsletter. For those of you that have not been to the Aberdeen outdoor range you have been missing a nice course with a variety of views from the creek that flows through the middle to the wooded areas scattered throughout. The trails are well maintained for easy walking from target to target. For those of you have shot the Aberdeen range but it has been a few years they have also rebuilt their club house a couple of years ago and who can forget their concessions with all of the homemade goodies. So make plans to attend the state outdoor field. Later in August the state 3-D will be held in Jefferson. The date for this tournament will be August 21st and 22nd. I am sure the Jefferson club will again put on a good tournament and assume they will be holding the team shoot on Saturday evening. Again for those of you that have not attended the state 3-D or stuck around for the team shoot you are missing a fun time. The team shoot normally consists of two archers selected on a handicap system. They will shoot a pre determined number of 3-D targets at various distances. Last year's event ended in a tie after the final target was shot so we got to have a shoot-off to decide the winning team. Before I forget to mention it the team shoot is a fun time for the spectators too since they get to watch their favorite archers and either heckle them or cheer them on. Cheering and talking is encouraged for this event. Shooting times and tournament locations are located elsewhere in this newsletter.

For those of you that were not able to attend the state indoor or the general membership meeting this past spring minutes of the general membership meeting, and scores are posted in Kathy's section. This year's indoor was held on March 27 and 28 in Sioux Falls where we saw some great weather along with attendance. First place in the men's freestyle division was tied after the first day and remained tied until the final arrow on Sunday's round. There were several other classes where the archers were neck and neck all the way to the

end. Congratulations to all of you that attended, also I want to congratulate the team from Brookings who went home with the traveling team trophy. If your school does not have this program yet and are interested have them give Curt Roberson with the Game, Fish and Parks a call and visit with him about getting a program started in your school.

FROM YOUR NFAA DIRECTOR

The Mid-West Outdoor Sectionals were held the last weekend in June in two locations, Yankton and Waverly IA. . The results for this shoot can be viewed on the NFAA website on the landing page under results. (www.fieldarchery.com).

I will be conducting a Range Inspection Class right after everyone is done on Sat. at the State Outdoor in Aberdeen and on Sat at the State 3D in Jefferson. So if you want to save your club some travel expenses for the area Governor to inspect your range please send someone from your club to one of these classes. Governors and class attendees are the only people other than myself authorized to inspect ranges. Attend the class and you will be authorized to inspect ranges for two years. You must re-certify every two years.

Another matter that needs your attention is updating your club charters and range inspections. Club Charters are good for one year. Range inspections, to include indoor, outdoor, 3D and bowhunter ranges are good for two years. Is your club charter expired?? Are your range inspections up to date?? Do you even use your range anymore? If you are unsure , I have a list of all expiration dates for Club Charters and Inspections. Call me if you have any questions at 605-772-4468, after 8pm. Remember, your NFAA insurance is not valid on your range unless your range inspection is current. Hope to see you all at the upcoming State Field and State 3-D.

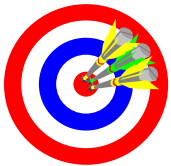

General Membership Meeting
March 27, 2010

The South Dakota Archers held a general membership meeting March 27, 2010 at the Minnehaha Archers Range after the Saturday shooting line of the State indoor. Board of Directors present were Tim Withers, Ron Lewon, Shorty Faber, Keith Hofer, Larry Johnson and Kathy Faber. Absent: Jon Hardesty, Paul Christensen and Al Kraus. 34 general members were present.

Minutes of the last General Membership meeting were read. Motion by Randy Ballard, second by Dwight Peschong to approve. Minutes approved.

Treasurers Report was given. Motion by Jeff Russo second by Ronn McDaniel to approve, report approved.

Russo inquired about e-mailing the newsletter. A discussion was had about the website. Kathy will build a new website and do the updating. The President and the Sec/Treas will have the passwords and authority to update the new site.

Shorty gave a NFAA Directors report. The NFAA will try having a Bi-annual meeting on a two year trial. Sectional meetings will remain annual. 3D rules have been adjusted to the 300 fps rule. Updated NFAA constitution is on the NFAA website. Traditional and Youth stakes at 40 yard max for 3D rule goes in effect June 1, 2010.

Elections: Nominations for NFAA director :

Trent Withers nominated Shorty Faber, Rick Hanson second, Don Iverson nominated Keith Hofer, Mike Long, second. Ron Lewon made a motion that nominations cease, Dwight Peschong second. A paper ballot was handed out. Shorty Faber was elected for a 2 yr. term. Ron made a motion to destroy the ballots, Larry Johnson second. Ballots destroyed.

Northeast area elected Arnie Veen as their governor.

Withers gave a report on the NASP state tournament being held in Mitchell.

Discussion was had about the dates for the 3D tournament. Arnie Veen made a motion that the policy read any weekend from the 2nd weekend in June to the 2nd weekend in August. Mark Lemmon second. Passed unanimously.

It was announced that Mitchell was awarded the bid for the 2011 state indoor.

Big Buck awards were presented to Rick Hanson, Sean Pinkert, and Shorty Faber.

Top Gun awards were presented to Randy Ballard, male unlimited, and Kathy Faber, Female unlimited.

Shorty will have a range inspection class if anyone is interested this evening or tomorrow.

Motion by Rick Hanson, Second by Trent to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.
