## Release of Liability, Hold Harmless, and Indemnification

This Release, Hold Harmless, and Indemnification covers all shows/clinics offered by the North Carolina Arabian Horse Association (NCAHA) for the 2020 year.

I apply to ride horses/ride in the arena/ride on trails and participate in or observe equine events provided and sponsored by the North Carolina Arabian Horse Association.

### WARNING

Under the North Carolina Equine Activity Liability Statute, Chapter 99 E, **an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in an equine activity resulting exclusively from the inherent risk of equine activity.** I understand that horseback riding will expose me to above normal risks. These risks include collisions, obstacles, variation in terrain and surface/subsurface conditions, and unexpected actions of a horse, such as kicking, biting, rearing, bucking, striking, rolling, bolting, or running away from danger by trotting, cantering or galloping. I also understand that I will be exposed to inherent risks of equine activity including but not limited to the unpredictability of an equine reaction to cattle, other animals, and sudden movement of people, sounds, and unfamiliar objects. I further understand that horses have a propensity to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to a person on or around it.

The NCAHA has put in place preventative measures aimed to reduce the spread of illnesses, including COVID-19, at its competitions; however, NCAHA cannot guarantee that participants or attendees will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending a competition could increase the risk of contracting an illness, including COVID-19. Anyone attending a NCAHA competition assumes the risk of contracting an illness, including the COVID-19 virus. I agree that I, ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) voluntarily, after having knowledge of the risks involved, hereby assume and acknowledge these and other dangers that are inherent in the activity of horseback riding. I agree that I am responsible for my own safety. I agree and represent to the organizers, sponsors, or operators of this North Carolina Arabian Horse Association (NCAHA) Show that I have my own medical coverage. I agree that the NCAHA, their members, employees, and agents will not be liable if I suffer personal injury or death, except if caused by their gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct. I agree not to bring any claims, demands or lawsuits against NCAHA, their members, employees or agents. I agree that if NCAHA, their members, employees or agents are sued by anyone else because of claimed conduct of myself, I will indemnify and hold them harmless for all damages and costs, including reasonable actual attorney fees. I agree that the consideration for this release to be binding on me, my heirs and assigns that I am permitted to participate in NCAHA activities or ride on property rented or in use for events. I specifically affirm and agree that this release constitutes a waiver of liability beyond the provisions of the North Carolina Equine Activity Liability Statute, Chapter 99 E. I agree that North Carolina law governs the interpretation and enforceability of this release. I represent that I am eighteen years of age or older, of sound mind, under no coercion, and that I am signing this release, hold harmless, and indemnification on my own behalf and on the behalf of my minor children, our heirs, representatives and assigns.

### 2020 COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

The following COVID-19 guidelines and protocols must be adhered to when competing and/or attending our competitions. In addition, all Federal, State, and local laws that may be applicable must be followed. Management reserves the right to change the guidelines and protocols when/if necessary.

*If you plan to come to the competition grounds, you must be able to assure management that neither you, nor anyone in your household has tested positive or been presumed positive for COVID-19 or has been advised to quarantine in the last 14 days. Additionally, that you or any household members have not in the last 24 hours had a fever greater than 100.4, a cough or shortness of breath.*

The following protocols are MANDATORY to be on the show grounds:

1. At this time only show staff members will be allowed in the show office during the show. There will be a window where you can turn in entry forms, do scratch and add forms and get any other assistance from office staff.
2. NO SCRATCHES OR ADDS WILL BE ACCEPTED BY RINGMASTER, GATE OFFICIALS, OR ANNOUNCER. THIS MUST BE DONE WITH THE SHOW OFFICE.
3. As a way to avoid risks we will only be accepting Checks or Credit Cards for the show. The credit card will have a 3% convenience charge added to the bill. Credit Cards will not be processed until the end of the show or when you are done showing. We can text or email you a copy of your check and show bill once the show is over. Please make sure you leave a good phone number and email for us to send these bills to.
4. There will be entry forms and waivers on our website [www.ncaha.com](http://www.ncaha.com) that can be filled out and printed and brought to the show office upon arrival.
5. There will be a waiver on the back of the entry form that must be signed in order for you to show. This is to cover the Horse Complex and TWHA.
6. Social Distancing must be followed at all times. Current guidelines call for 6' minimum spacing between individuals. In any instance where 6' spacing cannot be guaranteed, it is recommended that a mask or cloth face covering is used.
7. Do NOT gather in large groups.
8. Please do not crowd the ingate areas, Secretary Stand, Concessions, Schooling areas, and Bathrooms. Maintain social distance and follow signage and markings that help direct traffic flow.
9. For safety reasons we will NOT be providing water coolers and cups at the rings. Please be sure to supply your own water/beverages to stay hydrated. The Concessions provider will also have bottled water for sale.
10. We WILL offer concessions through Goblin Gourmet which is excellent at following all necessary protocols and has all health permits as well, however, opting to purchase food from this vendor is at your own risk. Goblin Gourmet will be located at the old cafeteria walk up window inside the arena.
11. There will be hand sanitizer located conveniently around the show grounds including at the Secretary Stand. Please follow good hygiene practices and frequently wash hands or use sanitizer.
12. Please use trash receptacles so that staff does not have to come in contact with contaminated items that are not discarded properly. Receptacles are located all around the show grounds. DO NOT LITTER! This is a facility wide rule, including out in the parking areas!!!! Think ahead, bring a trash bag to use at your trailer!
13. The Horse Complex is requesting that you use a mask when not riding a horse.
14. The Horse Complex is also requesting that only essential support team be on the show grounds for the show. We understand wanting friends and family there but we ask that you keep this to a limited number of people.

**Failure to follow guidelines may result in expulsion from the show grounds.**
