Competition Info:

Division 1 and Division 2 will be competing at the same time and scored separately

Seeds will be based on verifiable performances from all facilities from the 2023-'24 indoor season only

Declare the members of your relay teams on Athletic.net, if you change your team and it wins, a coach must report to the meet director to fill out a card listing the athletes names for publication

Coaches must make scratches at the scratch meeting prior to the meet. Any athlete not scratched from an individual running event prior to the meet will not be eligible to compete in a second relay

Only athletes that have met the standard should be entered

Athlete & School Participation Limitation:

Athletes may compete in up to one track event, one field event, and one relay event – OR – up to one field event and two relay events

Athletes entered into more than one individual running or one individual field event will be automatically scratched from the 2nd event listed in the order of events and must compete in the 1st event listed in the order of events per NFHS T&F Rule 4-2-2

Each school may enter up to a max of 3 athletes per event

Each school may enter only one relay per event

Field Events Info:

No runbacks will be allowed in the long jump, come with an established mark

The top 7 jumps from the preliminary flights in the Long Jump will move on to a one flight Final; which will immediately follow the preliminary flights

The top 7 throws from the preliminary flights in the Shot Put will move on to a one flight Final; which will immediately follow the preliminary flights

Clerking & Check In:

Field event athletes will check in at their field event by 10:40 a.m.

Check in and clerking for running events will take place in the same manner as they have been all season at the Reggie Lewis Center

Running event & relay teams should check in when they hear the 1st call for their event

Coaches & Athlete Restrictions: Coaches & athletes will <u>NOT</u> be allowed on the infield

There will be coaches boxes provided at both the high jump and long jump; one coach per team allowed

Athletes should only be on the infield when competing or being clerked; all other athletes will <u>NOT</u> be allowed on the infield

Please refrain from playing music in the fieldhouse

No personal electronic devices of any kind are allowed inside the competition area

Entry Procedure:

Log on to <u>www.athletic.net</u> to enter your athletes

Enter your individual athletes in their events along with a seed time or performance

All relays will be entered with the 4 names of competing athletes, along with the names of the alternates; as well as a seed performance

Each school is limited to 3 entries max per event.

No updating of seed times or performance will be accepted after the entry deadline

Any coach wishing to lower their relay team's seed time may do so at the meet by making a request to the meet director @ least two events prior in the event schedule

Scoring & Awards: 6 places score per event: 10-8-6-4-2-1

Team plaques will be presented to the Team Champions and Team Runner-Up at the conclusion of the meet for Division 1 and Division 2

Medals will be awarded to the 1st through 6th places

Please have athletes pick up their awards after results have been announced

Awards will be given out trackside shortly after the completion of the event
