## Martin Drive Neighborhood's 30th year Spooktacular is Friday, October 27th

## Here Is What You Need To Know:

Each year designated blocks are selected as the treating home area. Promptly at 7:15pm security monitors put up barricades, so that everyone is free to roam the area, crossing streets safely. To create this safe environment, we enlist volunteer help: teen and adult neighbors, and community liaisons.

This event is <u>for Martin Drive neighborhood residents' children, grandchildren, nieces & nephews "under the age of 13 only."</u> All children must be accompanied by an adult at registration and the night of trick-or treating.

Teens in costume are welcome to help monitor streets and volunteer to hand out candy. All children must be registered to participate. Families registering children are asked to contribute \$1 per registered child and a bag of candy (200 pieces or more) per every two children. Each registered child will receive a special labeled *Martin Drive Spooktacular yellow trick or treat bag.* The bag includes a few fun Halloween toys and the location of the treating area and identifies our registered children. They should be used at the event to collect the candy by our trick or treating ghosts and goblins.

## Registration will be:

- A. Register online at the Martin Drive website 24/7. Once registered the site will take you to a Go-Fund-Me site that is set up for payment. Candy needs to be labeled with the registered neighbor's name will need to be delivered within 3 days to 4145 W McKinley Ct. where a Halloween Tub will be outside on the front porch.
- B. 4145 W McKinley Ct. 24/7 (Forms and envelopes in Tub on porch) A registration tub as noted above will include registration forms and envelopes. Filled out forms and fee will go in the envelope, sealed and into the mail slot. Please make sure your candy is labeled with your name.
- C. Last minute and chance to register will be in person on Wednesday October 25th from 2pm to 8pm at 4145 W McKinley Ct.

Neighbors in the designated treating area are asked to be host trick or treat homes, decorating as desired, and are asked to provide 300 pieces of candy or be partially supplemented by the MDNA if needed. Thank them as go travel the treat or treat area with your little goblins.

Our nighttime Trick or Treating is always fun, as neighbors often come out in force, in costumes and in the spirit of making this a memorable experience for all.

All skateboards, bikes and dogs are not allowed for everyone's safety. (Not all children are unafraid of dogs.) Thank you for understanding.

Volunteers are needed to be candy hosts where neighbors cannot. There are usually 80-100 treating spots (including trick or Trunk & Treat cars hosted by our neighbors. Each treat will receive one piece of candy from each host.

Volunteers are needed to make this a great event, so please contact Terri Bartlett at: terribartlett007@gmail.com or 414-377-2645 to offer your help and please, leave a message, so she can return your call. 60-80 volunteers are needed outside of the treating homes. Volunteer opportunities include: 1. Registration and stuffing treat bags 2. Decorated trick or treat cars, 3. Passing out Halloween notices, 4. Candy sorting & distribution plus more.

Current need is for 6-10 volunteers to be in charge of contacting 15-20 homes on specified treating streets. Notices will be shared with the host homes asking for them to be candy hosts homes, information will be collected and if no one is home, notices will be left and volunteers will return a few days later to pick up agreements as noted on the forms.
