## **Newsletter Publishing Schedule Changes**

Hi Neighbors, Changes are in the works for the Martin Drive Newsletter. I have decided, going forward, to publish the newsletter only once a year, as paper issue, beginning this fall. I have come to this decision because of a lack of information flow to me, the lack of assistance in generating and collecting ads, and the preference for Face book, listserv and the web site as the neighborhood's information exchange.

Ad pricing will be adjusted for the yearly newsletter to cover the printing costs. Existing ad packages will be honored and most will expire with this issue. I expect the ad prices to drop about \$10.00 a year for most of our business supporters with exception of the 1-inch ads price, which will remain the same price of \$38.00, as it is already deeply discounted. The standard 2-inch by one column wide, on a four column page, will be \$65.00 vs the old rate of \$75.00 unless printing costs rise.

I will publish special editions as requested by the coordinating committee, paper or electronic, when they supply stories, or news items in a paper or electronic format, what ever they desire. If paper a edition is requested, the requesters will need to provide funding, or an advertiser to cover the printing costs. Paper newsletters need to be either 4 or 8 pages as that is the most cost effective.

If someone is interested in working with me to learn publishing, I would be happy to train them. I use Microsoft Publisher. Having that program will make it easier to learn how to publish the newsletter and we can work together or I can step aside. Thanks DJ
