



# Summer Dumpster Clean-Up Schedule

For your convenience, we have scheduled dumpsters to be placed in the neighborhood throughout the summer months. We encourage you to keep your block clean and set a good example. Here's the schedule:

May 23, June 20	On 42nd @ McKinley Blvd.
June 6, Aug. 8	On Juneau between 43rd & 44th
June 13, Aug. 22	On Juneau Between 44th & 45th
May 23, Sept. 6	On Juneau between 45th & 46th
June 6, Sept 19	On Juneau & 46th

Bulky items that do not fit inside the dumpster should be placed at the curb for special pick-up. Do not dispose of tires, concrete, used motor oil, refrigerators, stoves, yard waste, or recyclables in these dumpsters. These items must be taken to the Self-Help station at 3879 W. Lincoln Ave. for disposal.

#### Pitbun & Rottweiler Ordinance

While these dogs can be friendly and good pets they can also be a very strong aggressive dog. Milwaukee has a special ordinance pertaining to these two breeds of dogs. Copies of the ordinance are available through the Department of City Development, 286-5771.

You may be jeopardizing your homeowner's insurance policy by owning one of these dogs.

#### Highlights of the ordinance include:

- · Animals must be leashed.
- Owner must have a fence or kennel.
- Owner must attend a dog behavior class once each year.
- Any person who walks a pitbull or rottweiler must be at least 16 years old and able to control the animal.

### Neighborhood Pride

(The Three P's)

#### **Property Pride**

- Maintain your property's appearance.
- Pick up litter, even if it's not yours.
- Keep your lawn mowed and trimmed.
- Return the trash receptacle to your yard.

#### Pet Pride

- Pick up after your pet, in your yard, the neighborhood, and the park.
- Be conscious that your barking dog is a disturbance to neighbors.
- · Leash your pet at all times.

#### Peace & Quiet

- Supervise your own kids.
- Be aware that loud music is a disturbance.
- · Honking horns are a disturbance.
- Loud voices are a disturbance.
- Be aware of 10 p.m. noise curfew and 11 p.m. child curfew.


These items are law and are punishable by fines. However, we hope respect for neighbors will be the reason to comply. Thank you.
