- You may leave Dress Rehearsal after your dancer's last number unless specified by DGI Staff.
- All hair and makeup **MUST** be fixed correctly for Dress Rehearsal as indicated on Costume Sheet.
- Your dancer **IS** allowed to be in costume in the auditorium for Dress Rehearsal, **but absolutely no costumes are allowed in the auditorium for Dance Revue.**
- The following Awards will be given out on Friday prior to Dress Rehearsal, **IN THEIR FIRST COSTUME:**
 - 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th, 13th, 15th Year
 - Perfect Attendance
 - Hardest Worker (chosen by staff)
 - Full Out Award (chosen by staff)
- Graduate Awards will take place on stage at 5:30 PM on Saturday prior to the Show.

Dancers in the first 5 numbers of the show should arrive backstage FULLY DRESSED IN COSTUME at least 30 minutes prior to show time.

*****ABSOLUTELY NO COSTUMES IN THE AUDITORIUM!!!!**

NO, YOU CANNOT WEAR A ROBE OR CLOTHES OVER YOUR COSTUME IN THE AUDITORIUM!!!!***

- Any **additional** tickets (beyond your family's four tickets) to be purchased will be \$15 (Cash), \$17 (billed to account).
- Line up in the Ballroom 3 numbers before your own number for Dress Rehearsal and Dance Revue. DGI Staff will be lining kids up. **WE WILL NOT HOLD A NUMBER IF YOUR DANCER IS LATE!**
- If your dancer will be in the audience at any time, she DOES need a ticket.
- Absolutely no parents or volunteers are allowed in the backstage area. Do not be offended if someone on DGI Staff asks you to move. They are following the directions of Lainey & Michala.
- Absolutely no panties allowed under costumes!!!

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ONLINE PRE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE: JUNE 18

- Pre-registration for the 2022-2023 dance year will be done online. Those registering online and paying by June 18 will reserve space for next year and save \$10 on registration. In order to register go to www.dancegraphicsinc.com, click Customer Portal Login, login to your account, click Find Classes, click 2022-2023 Pre-Registration, click Enroll In This Class, select student. The \$50 fee will be added to your online account.

- Other classes may have extra rehearsals throughout the month of June. Check the BAND app.

BACKSTAGE PASSES

- Each family will receive one Backstage Pass wristband for the mom or individual dressing the dancer. This wristband will serve as a backstage pass which allows you to enter and re-enter the stage door only. This Backstage Pass is **NOT** equivalent to a Revue Ticket.
- No brothers, sisters, friends, etc are allowed backstage.
- No dads or male guardians are allowed backstage/in dressing rooms.

TICKETS

- Each family will be given 4 tickets included in your Revue Fee.
- EVERYONE must have a Ticketmaster ticket to enter and exit the theater at any time. Your ticket will be scanned to enter & exit the auditorium every time you enter and exit. The doors NEAREST THE FRONT of the building will be used to exit and re-enter during the show (Townhouse side opposite the hospital).
- If you or your dancer plans to be in the audience at any time during the Revue, you will need a ticket to enter.

ADDITIONAL TICKETS

- Additional Revue Tickets are available for purchase for \$15.
- Tickets MUST be paid for by Monday, May 2 or your tickets will go to the next person in line.
- If you do not wish to use all 4 of your tickets, please let Michala know.
- We will accept the following methods of payment for extra tickets:
 1. Cash (in envelope with dancer's full name on it)
 2. Check (payable to Dance Graphics, put dancer's name on memo line)
 3. Bill to Account (\$17/ticket due to credit card processing fees)
- Starting June 3, all tickets will be sold through the Ticketmaster, contact them directly. If you need tickets prior to June 3, email Michala.

COSTUMES

- All costumes, accessories, shoes, and costume instruction sheets should be brought to the Heymann Center with you on June 18. Please check that you have all the pieces in your dance bag.

- Dancer's hair **MUST** be fixed as indicated on the Costume Sheets. DGI Staff has permission to adjust any dancer's hair who did not follow directions.

DRESSING ROOMS

- Each class will be assigned a designated area/room to change in for Revue. When you enter the backstage area, there will be signs directing you to your assigned area.
- If your dancer is in the Ballroom area, Tents are allowed. Please just respect the given space and keep your items together. **Please also kindly pick up your trash when you exit.**

DAD'S DANCE

- We will have a Dad's Dance in the show.
- A separate email will go out with details and choreography times.
- Stage practice: Thursday, June 16 at 6 PM, Heymann Center

ACCOUNT BALANCES

- All accounts must be up to date on May 10 in order to be eligible for extra tickets. If your account is not paid, your name will be skipped until paid.
- All accounts not paid by May 11 will be assessed a \$10 Late Fee.
- If your account is not up to date by June 1st, you will not receive your tickets until the balance is paid.
- If your account is still outstanding when we get to the Heymann, your dancer will not be allowed on stage. No excuses.

FOOD

- No food or drink is allowed inside the Auditorium. Food IS allowed in the dressing rooms.

PROGRAMS

- Programs will be distributed June 15-17 at the Heymann Center. Come to the first row of the Auditorium to check in and pick yours up. One program per family is included in your Revue Fee.
- Additional programs will be available to purchase for \$10.

REVUE HINTS

- Follow all instructions of Stage Crew and Dance Graphics Staff. If you have any questions, ask them. If they do not know the answer to your question, they will be sure to find out for you.
- Be on time
- Have all personal belongings clearly labeled with dancer's name
- Stay in designated dressing room
- Absolutely NO PANTIES under your tights or costume.
- Absolutely NO jewelry on stage, unless part of your costume.
- Wear more browns/neutrals in your eyeshadow to enhance the eyes. This will make the eyes stand out. NO purples or blues - they are too bright with the stage lights.

Please make every effort to get your dancer to class each and every week!
