

Ordinance 2011-03-15-1

2009 International Fire Code

An ordinance of the City of Timpson, Texas, adopting the 2009 edition of the International Fire Code, regulating and governing the safe guarding of life and property from fire and explosion hazards arising from the storage, handling, and use of hazardous substances, materials, and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and premises in the City of Timpson; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees thereof; repealing all other ordinances and parts of the ordinances in conflict therewith

The City Council of the City of Timpson does ordain as follows:

Section 1 That the 2009 International Fire Code , including appendix chapters, is on file in the office of the Secretary of The City of Timpson , as published by the International Code Council, and is hereby adopted as the Fire Code of the City of Timpson, in the State of Texas regulating and governing the safeguarding of life and property from fire and explosion hazards arising from storage, handling, and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and premises as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees thereof; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms of said Fire Code are hereby referred to , adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, if any prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section II That the following sections are hereby revised

Section 1.01 Insert City of Timpson

Section III

Section 3204.2.9.6.1 The storage of Class I and Class II liquids in above ground tanks outside of buildings is prohibited in the entire City of Timpson, Texas ; Exceptions: as approved by Fire Marshal

Section 3406.2.4.4 The storage of Class I and II liquids in above ground tanks is prohibited in the entire City of Timpson, Texas; Exceptions: as approved by Fire Marshal

Section 3506.2 The Storage of flammable cryogenic fluids in stationary containers is prohibited in the entire City of Timpson, Texas, Exceptions: as approved by Fire Marshal

Section 3804.2 The storage of liquefied petroleum gas is prohibited in the entire City of Timpson, Texas,
Exceptions: as approved by Fire Marshal


Section IV. Conflicting Ordinances- All ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance as adopted are hereby amended to the extent of such conflict. In the event of a conflict or inconsistency between this ordinance and any other code or ordinance of the City of Timpson, the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section V. Savings Clause- That nothing in this ordinance or in the Fire Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section IV of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this ordinance.

Section VI. Effective Date- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code


