

July/August Missions/Fundraiser 100 Envelope Building/Heating Challenge!!!

Have you ever heard of the 100 Day Savings Challenge? We would like to try this with a little bit of a twist. The church heating bill has always been high due to the size of our building and the New England weather. This year we are going to take the idea of a 100 day savings challenge and have our congregation help us to get our current heating bill lower and help to get a jump start on our upcoming year heating cost.

Here's how it works!

100 envelopes will be placed on a few boards out in the Narthex (in front in the sanctuary). Each envelope will have a money value written on the outside \$1-\$100.



- You are able to pick whatever envelope that is available.
- o Place the money value written on the envelope on the inside.
- Once the envelope is filled, please seal it and place it into an offering plate.
- We handle the rest!

There is a space for you to place your name and address so that this donation will be added to your personal giving account.

If we are at another church do not worry, the envelopes will make it back to Park Place as they are also labeled on the back. The envelope value you want or can afford is already taken, but you still want to help out?

That's ok, just bring your donation and a little note saying for Building/Heating, place it in the offering plate or hand it to any of Park Place collectors, we will make sure your donation gets to the correct place.

For many people, relaxing by a campfire is a favorite summer activity. Nestling into the surrounding darkness while gazing into dancing flames, we sense God's love and let the day's chaos go. In contrast, Exodus 24:17 describes, "Now the appearance of the glory of God was like a devouring fire."

God, your presence is like a consuming fire — not destructive, but transformative, not the fire of anger but the flame of love, the fire of glassblowers and bakers the grace to make us more beautiful, strong and useful. Your glory is no tame campfire where we sit and make s'mores. It burns out of our control. The furnace of your love roars about our hearts, remaking us Teach us to be unafraid. ...

When you bask in firelight glow — and maybe eat some s'mores! — ponder how God is transforming you with love, and for the sake of love.
