CD PRODUCTION MEETING

November 13, 2010

UC Davis Arboretum

Present: Bill Allen, Mike Johnson, Chris Mosher, Greg Sweatt, Eric Totman, Mac Wright

These are the notes and votes from the meeting:

- 1) It was voted to include Marty's song notes in the CD insert (no "Civil War history" blurb inside, though).
- 2) The insert will be 6 pages, if needed for the inclusion of all the song notes, otherwise 4 pages.
- 3) A short FPGBB history will be included, but only if there's space available after the song notes are put in.
- 4) The CD recording notes/history, as written by Eric and Bill, will be included, as should be photo credits.
- 5) PHOTOS: The "cannon photo" (which shows all the FPGBB personnel who recorded on the CD) will be the cover photograph (5 votes "yes," Marty "yes" by proxy).
The humorous "backwards facing" color FPGBB photograph will be on the back of the CD (4 "yes" votes), with Eric to crop the picture in order to fit in the song list (all agreed).
The photo of the FPGBB on the 2nd tier with the bass drum in the foreground to be inside the CD.
- 6) The inside paper insert should be printed black on white (4 "yes" votes).
- 7) The CD itself will have a picture of the FPGBB bass drum head on it.
- 8) 1,000 CD's should be produced, with the expense not to exceed \$2,000 (4 "yes" votes, 3 "no" votes, Marty "no" by proxy). Bill pointed that a 1,000 run production could deplete the Band's funds.
- 9) The CD graphics will be our own; no outside company will design them, thus saving the Band some money.
