OLD BUSINESS: The FPGBB voted unanimously to make the Mike Johnson Memorial Scholarship a \$1,000 non-renewable award for a San Jose State music student.

NEW BUSINESS: The FPGBB voted unanimously to pay Scott Pierson, San Jose State Band Director, \$150 to conduct a FPGBB clinic at UC Davis. Tentative date to be April 13, 2013.

Mac will look into the possibility of the Band playing in Prather, California, again (as we did in October 2012) at church services there. Any collection the congregation wishes to make to the Band will be asked to be made to the Mike Johnson Memorial Scholarship.

Discussion was had as to non-performing persons staying with the FPGBB at the "band house" outside of Gettysburg this summer "pay their stay." This is due to the fact that more non-performing people are going back to Gettysburg for the 150th Anniversary Reenactment and planning to stay at the house than the Band originally anticipated. Mac moved (Greg second) that non-performing persons staying at the "band house" pay \$250 for their lodging. Marty mentioned that this is still a pretty good deal for a stay of at least a week.
