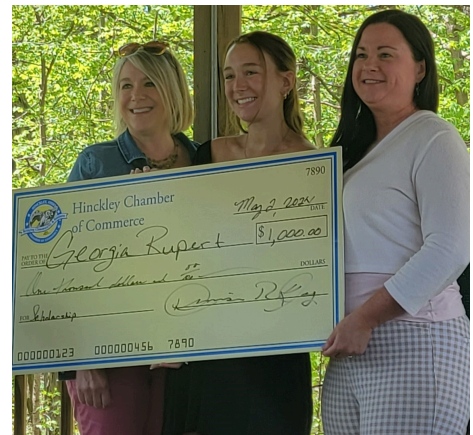


Scholarship Committee:

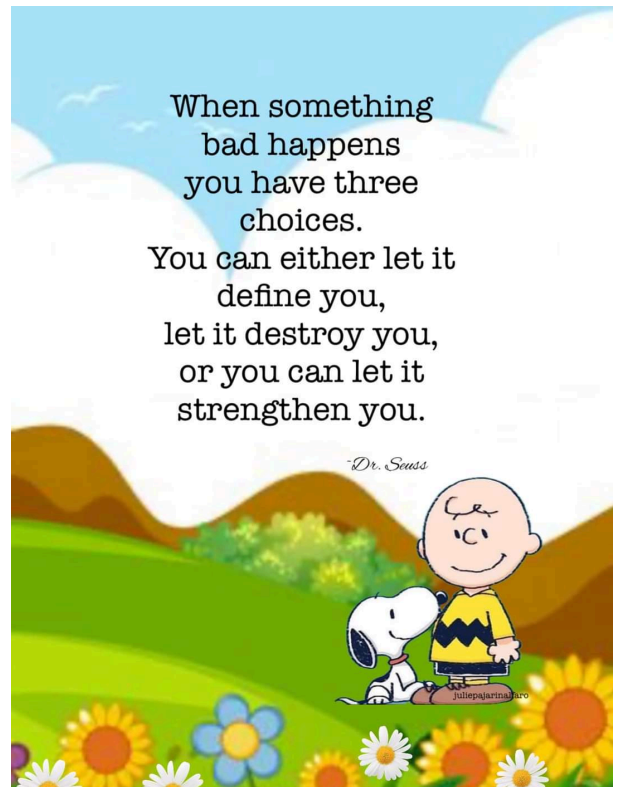

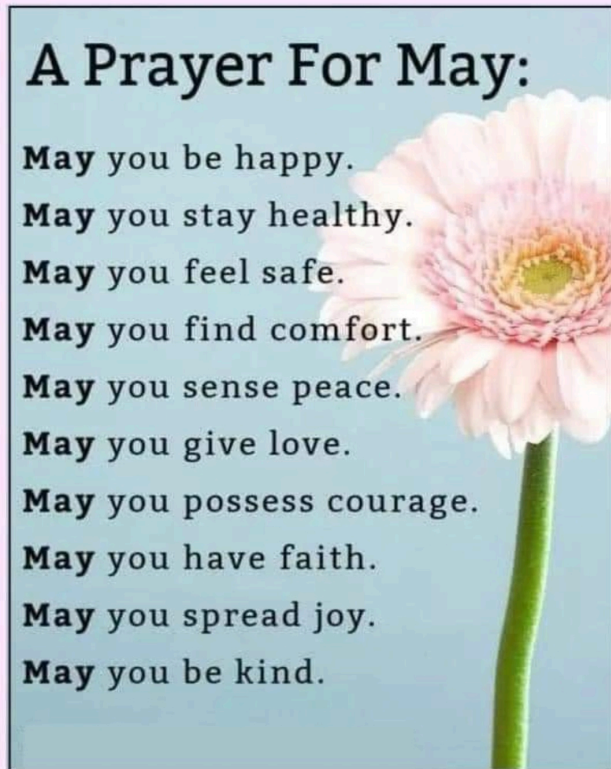

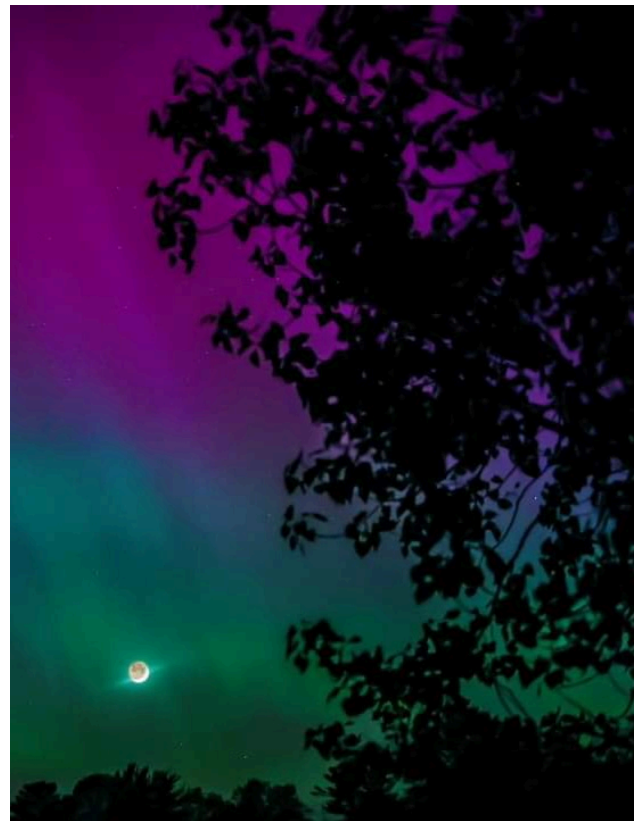
