From the Pastor's Desk

Buy an Extra Cup... For the Church!

It happens every day in every small town that I have ever been in, and in bigger towns and cities too. People gather around coffee. It doesn't matter if it's a gas station or cafe or a high end coffee shop with a barista behind the counter, people show up and spend, I don't know... two, three, four, maybe even five or six dollars for something to drink as they sit

down, either with a good book, or work, or with friends. Much of the time the money paid seems like such a small amount that it just doesn't seem to be that big of a deal. It's just paid.

In our family we like to take a break at coffee shops while we are spending the day shopping for our groceries and supplies. It's a nice refresher in the middle of the afternoon. And again we just pay for it. We aren't too worried about breaking the bank because we went for coffee.

A couple of months ago at a council meeting at St. Luke's, (don't worry I have permission to share this.) Gene Zempel suggested that we, "Buy an extra cup of coffee for Church." I thought it was a great idea! Here is an amount that we spend many times over the week or month and don't give it too much thought. Yet when it is added up it becomes significant! I did some quick math, a \$3 cup of coffee, 20 times in a month turns into \$720 in a year!

When we buy a cup of coffee it's not just about the coffee, it's the people there and the atmosphere that give that cup its value. The same is true as we give our offering to the Church. We support our local community that we participate in as we gather with one another. But, we also support and participate in a movement throughout the world that brings hope and help to many that are in need and allow others to hear the Good News of Jesus. That is certainly worth a cup of coffee!

Imagine if we all bought the Church a cup of coffee every time we had a cup. What would we be able to change in this world for the kingdom of God?


