From the Pastor's Desk

So it was just yesterday that we got back from our two week trip in honor of our 25th wedding anniversary. So my head is filled with many images of the things that we were able to see, hear, taste and experience during that time away. My overall impression of southeast Alaska and the Pacific Northwest is immense!

The mountains that you sail by through the Inside Passage of Alaska are breathtaking! And hiking through the old growth forests that are so green and lush was an opportunity to feel just how small I am as the trees towered

above me. It brought to my mind Psalm 8 which in part says:

O Lord, our Sovereign, how majestic is your name in all the earth! ... When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars that you have established; what are human beings that you are mindful of them, mortals that you care for them? Yet you have made them a little lower than God, and crowned them with glory and honor. You have given them dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under their feet...

These great and glorious things that I was able to see have been given to us for us to see the majesty and glory of God in the works of God's hands. It is easily seen in the God's grand works like mountains and trees but it is also seen in the small and intricate way these grand things are held together.

While on a hike at Mount Rainier National Park I learned again about nurse trees. These are trees that have died and fallen to the forest floor. They then trap moisture and nutrients and as they decay they become a source for water and food as new plants take root even in the old tree itself (see the picture on the cover page) bringing about new life in the forest. And the cycle of life continues.

All of these things, from the greatest to the smallest, we as humans have been given dominion over to use and to care for.

In the grand scheme of things we are not very big. Many things tower over us. Yet God in all wisdom has chosen us to care for what God has made. We have been given a hard task.
