From the Pastor's Desk

As I sit down to write this there are a few snowflakes in the air. The temperature has dropped a little bit. We have not had Thanksgiving but a step inside any store will tell you that Christmas is right around the corner. It is easier to think about now that this morning feels a little more wintery but it still seems a long way off. But the stores have started pushing. "Christmas is coming!" They say, "Don't wait until the last minute!"

I am not sure why it happens, well, that might not be entirely true. It happens because of the hope they have that by starting to spend earlier we will spend more. The stores prepare all the displays and get everything ready for us and then wait. Wait for us to come and fulfill their hopes by buying everything.

As much as I hate the practice of having Christmas decorations out on the shelves before the Halloween ones have been used I get what the stores are up to. They are preparing for what is to come. They are getting ready and waiting for our arrival. Hoping for success. They in their own way are having Advent.

Because of the hype that Christmas gets every year in the commercial world Advent is often overlooked and forgotten in the month of December. Yet without it Christmas seems less impactful. The Church year begins with Advent and covers a lot of ground in the four Sundays that lead up to Christmas Day. I have heard it said (I don't know who said it first) that in Advent we celebrate Christ's coming in history, mystery and majesty. And we prepare for his coming now and at the end of time as we await his birth in Bethlehem. Like I said, that's a lot!

Probably the place to start is what we think of when we think of preparing for Christmas.
