From the Pastor's Desk

Last night as we returned home from a ball game after the sun went down, we stepped out to get the mail and we saw our first lighting bugs of the season. We had just been discussing when they show up for the summer and neither of us were quite sure. So we paused in the shadow of a tree for a minute and waited. Then first Becca saw one, or thought she saw one, and then a few moments later I was able to say yes, the lighting bugs are here!

I have always been fascinated with these little bugs as they flit around in the darkened world and use light to find each other and stay together even in a dark and foreboding landscape.

It is kind of strange that I have never thought about a lighting bug and then thought about who we are as followers of Jesus. We are, just as lighting bugs, small bits of light bouncing around in this darkened world doing what we can to share that light. We, unlike lighting bugs, tend to get distracted by all of the darkness that seems to be swallowing up everything around us. The lighting bugs don't seem to care. And when you think about it, when it truly dark out, when there seems to be no light at all, that is when you can see those little lighting bugs the best.

As followers of Jesus our call is to be very much like those lighting bugs dancing around the grass in the dark, showing off our light, letting everyone know where we are. Our call it only to light up and share the light, not to worry about the darkness. And when the world seems to be only darkness, remember that is when the light shines brightest.

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overtake it.
