Agenda Item 1 – CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING PROPOSED 2022 TAX RATE FOR FY2023 BUDGET – COUNTY AUDITOR – Judge Lee reported the No New Revenue Rate

Judge Lee reported after review of the expenses presented, it is determined that the level of the proposed 2022 tax rates needed to fund the FY 2023 budget are as follows:

Total Proposed 2022 Tax Rate for FY 2023 Budget: .40012
