- OSSF Max received requested documentation from TCEQ regarding septic rules for subdivisions. He will provide recommended updates at the next regular meeting;
- General subdivision rules may need to be updated;
- Clock update Judge Lee has found a company who can repair it, making it an electric clock without need for the counterweights. Quote is approximately \$15k;
- Generator from ATCOG going to contact the Generator Supercenter in Tyler to see if they can hook it up and service it going forward. Need to know if it will power everything in the courthouse, or if each official will need to provide a list of things for their office;
- Ball fields and budget will be discussed in this afternoon's workshop.
