- \$150.00 deposit due for multi day trips and remaining balance is due as listed on the Reservation Form.
- Pay the full amount for each trip.
- Seats are assigned according to date paid in full. (Front to back of the bus)
- Please mark on Reservation Form who you want to sit with and if you have any problems that require sitting in the front of bus (such as motion sickness or handicapped).
- Please arrive at Pick-up Points 5 – 10 minutes ahead of departure time. The bus can only wait 10 minutes for late arrivals.

### **Cancellations - One Day Trip to a ticketed event**

- If notice of cancellation is given within 30 days prior, L & L Tours & Travel shall contact those persons placed on a waiting list to replace the cancellation. If no one can fill that seat/s, the individual/s will be requested to find a replacement on their own. No refund will be given unless the venues will refund the money already paid for trip.

### **Cancellations – Multi-day Trip**

- Full Refund up to 30 days prior to trip unless there are unrecoverable deposits / expenses by terms and conditions of the tour vendors. If the cancellation is made within 30 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee is \$10.00 per person, per travel day, plus any fees that cannot be recovered. Anyone who does not show on the day of tour departure will not receive refund.

## DAY 1

Join us as we travel to Norfolk, VA for three days of fun! Our two night stay will be at the Sleep Inn Lake Wright. You will see multiple ports, coal piers and Navy ships and submarines docked at any given time at Naval Station.

## DAY 2

Visit the museum and then enjoy a self-guided tour of the Battleship Wisconsin—the largest battleship that served in WWII, the Korean War and the Persian Gulf War. We will enjoy a waffle cone demonstration and ice cream tasting at Doumar's. Lunch will be on your own and shopping at

Norfolk Premium Outlets. In the afternoon we will visit the Botanical Gardens, which dates to 1938 and is considered a premiere example of horticultural excellence. Take a tram to explore 155-acres where we will see a variety of spring blooms. We will then

make our way to the Hullabaloo outdoor pre-show at the Scope Arena where you will have dinner on your own choosing from a variety of food trucks and restaurants. **The highlight of the trip will be this evening the performance of the International Tattoo!** The heartbeat of the 2024 Virginia International Tattoo will be its incredible international cast featuring more than 800 performers - with bands and drill teams from the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps joined by civilian and military performers from 7 nations. You will see returning favorites including Switzerland's *Top Secret Drum Corps* and the *Netherlands Royal Marine Band* and first time performers that are sure to become new favorites. Not to be forgotten are the *Massed Pipes and Drums* from 4 nations who will be joined by the incredible *Virginia International Tattoo Highland Dance Company*.

The soul of the 2024 Tattoo will be an emotional and grateful **Celebration of Freedom**, 80 years from the D-Day landings and 75 years from the founding of NATO. This Tattoo will remind us that as Americans, we have helped write some of the greatest chapters in the story of human freedom. With stirring music, historic photos and video, tributes from US military bands and appearances by special guests, we will remember and celebrate the men and women who have safeguarded freedom not only for the United States, but for the world.

### DAY 3

After breakfast we will check out and depart for Quantico, VA where we will visit the National Museum of the Marine Corps and a guided intro to the Missing in America project at the National Cemetery. The National Museum of the Marine Corps is a lasting tribute to the commitment, accomplishments, and sacrifices of U.S. Marines. Situated on a 135-acre site adjacent to Marine Corps Base Quantico, Virginia, and under the command of Marine Corps University, the Museum's soaring design evokes the images of the flag raisers of Iwo Jima and beckons visitors to this 240,000-square-foot structure. World-class interpretive exhibits with innovative technology and unique artifacts surround visitors and immerse them in the sights and sounds of Marines in action. We will then head for home taking with us all the memories of our trip!!
