- \$150.00 deposit due for multi day trips and remaining balance is due as listed on the Reservation Form.
- Pay the full amount for each trip.
- Seats are assigned according to date paid in full. (Front to back of the bus)
- Please mark on Reservation Form who you want to sit with and if you have any problems that require sitting in the front of bus (such as motion sickness or handicapped).
- Please arrive at Pick-up Points 5 – 10 minutes ahead of departure time. The bus can only wait 10 minutes for late arrivals.

Cancellations - One Day Trip to a ticketed event

- If notice of cancellation is given within 30 days prior, L & L Tours & Travel shall contact those persons placed on a waiting list to replace the cancellation. If no one can fill that seat/s, the individual/s will be requested to find a replacement on their own. No refund will be given unless the venues will refund the money already paid for trip.

Cancellations – Multi-day Trip

- Full Refund up to 30 days prior to trip unless there are unrecoverable deposits / expenses by terms and conditions of the tour vendors. If the cancellation is made within 30 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee is \$10.00 per person, per travel day, plus any fees that cannot be recovered. Anyone who does not show on the day of tour departure will not receive refund.

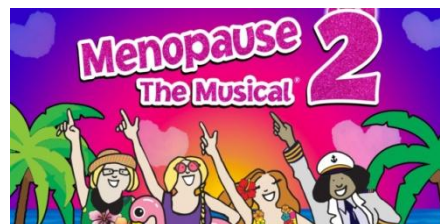

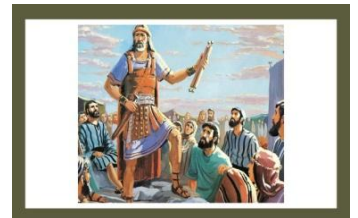

Wednesday, October 21

Thursday, October 22

Today's wilderness excursion is the New Tygart Flyer, departing from the town of Elkins. This route features an "S" curve tunnel, a high bridge and miles of unspoiled mountain views. The vintage diesel-powered locomotive climbs along the cascading Shavers Fork of the Cheat River to the High Falls which are accessible only by train. The closest road is literally five miles away. Next we will explore the West Virginia Railroad Museum located in the historic Darden Mill in Elkins, West Virginia—a city that was built by the railroads.
