## Appendix to February 2016 Discovery Digest Volume 19 Issue 7

## To: All Brethren of Discovery Lodge # 149

Dues for the year 2016 are now past due.

The dues structure for Discovery Lodge is as follows:

Total Cost	<del>\$191.00</del>
The assessment for the Cancer Car project	17.00
Lodge Dues	174.00

**Section 6 (a)** of our by-laws clearly states that dues for the next calendar year are payable in advance, that is to say <u>before December 31 of the current calendar year</u>. After this date, a member is considered delinquent in his dues and will receive notification from the Dues Committee/Secretary confirming his delinquency.

## Regulation R16.4 of our Constitution clearly states:

If your dues are not paid in full by March 31st, the matter will be placed before the next Regular Communication of the Lodge unless:

- a. Your dues are paid, or
- b. Your failure to pay is due to sickness or any other misfortune (at which time you must contact your Worshipful Master)

## Regulation R16.5 of our Constitution clearly states:

Every Lodge has the power to suspend from the privileges of the Lodge any Member for non-payment of dues.

Please comply with the by-laws of our Lodge.
