Board of General Purposes meeting July 27,2020

Brethren present:

Jim Whyte, David Freeman, Bill Rogers, Bob Lowe, Brian Dickson, Dave Wardell, Dave Sinclaire, Dave Storrie, Pat Palmer, Rob Mason, Dan Wilson.

Meeting convened at 7:05pm with all Covid protocols in place as per the directive of Grand Lodge. Seats were spaced to allow social distancing in the repass hall of Discovery Lodge #149.

Agenda items:

- 1 The increase in Grand Lodge percapita.
- 2 How to open the lodge
- 3 How to deal with the Installation of Officers
- 4 How to deal with the candidates in waiting

Results:

- 1 The general discussion led to holding to the Discovery Lodge #149 bylaws. The overall dues payable will rise by \$6. Life members will pay \$94 and general members will pay \$207.
- 2 The Lodge may be opened in the lodge room on an as-needed basis. There will not be regular meetings. Lodge meetings will be by invitation only to assure we maintain Covid protocol. Meetings may be held with lodge officers only.
- 3 Grand Lodge does not allow for a Board of Installed Masters, therefore we may not install the master elect. Therefore, the decision was made to carry over the officers until such time that we may return to normal proceedings.
- 4 Grand Lodge does not allow for the conferring of degrees, therefore we may not initiate the 2 candidates or raise the existing FC.
