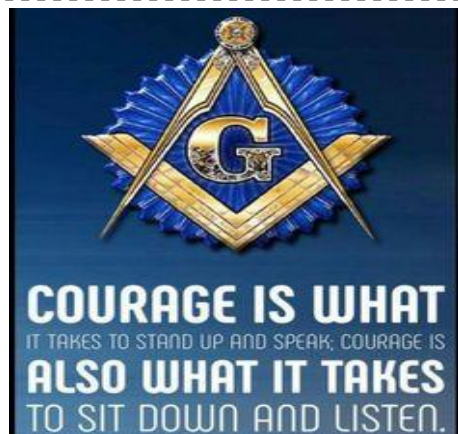

Update for 2021
