The Letter G:

In Hebrew, the language our Bible was

originally written in, it is called Gheemel (or Gimel) and has a numerical value of 3. Throughout history, we see reference to the number 3 when we speak of God. No matter which language we speak in. Gimel is the 3rd letter of many Semitic languages including Phoenician. Greek, Aramaic, Hebrew, and Svriac. The letter Freemasonry stands for both God and Geometry. The "G" is not used in the center of the square and compasses in all iurisdictions around the world.
