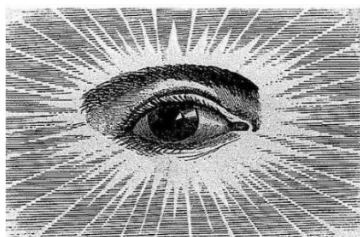

MASONIC SHOE (SLIPPER)



The Masonic shoe is also known as the Blue slipper. The name 'Blue slipper' ascertains the value the color Blue holds in Freemasonry. In the olden days, removing a shoe and handing it to someone else was a way of validating a contract.

The Masonic shoe connotes various meanings according to different degrees. In the First Degree, it symbolizes a pledge and accepting to enter into a covenant. In the Third Degree, it connotes the removal of shoes when in a Holy Place. It is a reflection of different religious practices. Moses was commanded to take his shoes off when he saw the burning bush. It, therefore, serves as an affirmation that what has been said will be done.
