The Pillars



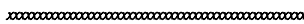

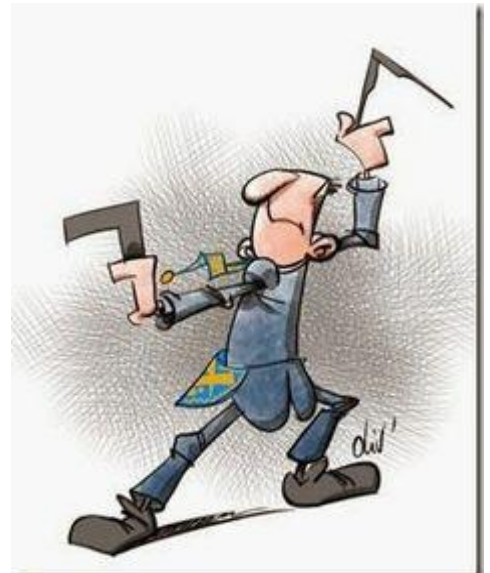
