Brethren:

Thanks to all the support you showed by attending the Northern Lights Degree Team Pub Night, it was a great day. I enjoyed seeing many I haven't in a while and being part of the Little McSeventy players. This month we will have a social party with our 1950's Sock Hop themed Murder Mystery on Nov. 2nd, which should be lots of fun and as it is purely social and not particularly masonic. All are welcome to attend. So, dress up in your best poodle skirt, or don a leather jacket, or a preppy bow tie and come out for a great time.

November, the last month of Autumn is often a month associated with remembering our loved ones with 2 holidays dedicated to this task (Nov 1st- All Saints Day, and Nov 11th - Remembrance Day). November is also a bit strange, as the month was named after the Latin root for "Nine", it being originally the ninth month in early Roman calendars. In the Masonic Calendar, November marks the feast day of the Four Crowned Martyrs (Nov 8th), or Quatuor Coronati, they were often the patrons of Operative Masonry. Around the year 287, there were 5 sculptors that refused to make a statue of pagan gods. They were then sentenced to death by Roman Emperor Diocletian. Two years later, there were 4 soldiers who likewise refused to pray at pagan statues and were similarly sentenced to death by the same Emperor. These martyrs were confused together and called 4 Crowned Martyrs, even though there were 2 separate groups with 9 total martyrs (oddly like how Nov. was originally the 9th month). Freemasons adopted them as patron saints as well due to their close association with stonemasonry. In fact, one of the best Masonic scholarly journals in the world is *Ars Quatuor Coronatorum*, named after the 4 Crowned Martyrs, and being the transactions of a UK Lodge of Education likewise named

after the martyrs. This Quatuor Coronati Lodge No 2076 Installation Dinner (Nov. 14th) the keynote speaker is none other than BC's own RWBro Trevor McKeown who will be installed as the Worshipful Master of that Lodge on that day. Congratulations that is an accomplishment.

Our Nov. Regular meeting this month, we will have a short Remembrance ceremony and deal with some of the business of Lodge before Dec. I hope all will also support their local civil Remembrance Day ceremony. 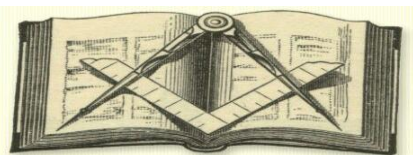
