Brethren:

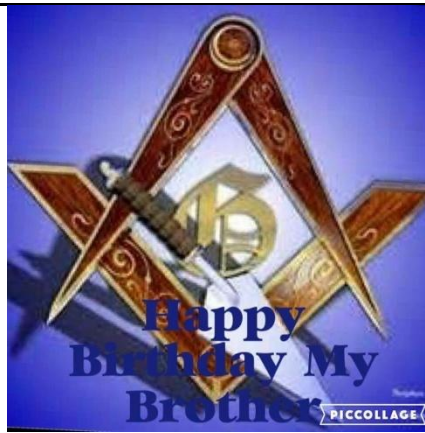
