

### The Anchor and the Ark

In today's confusing world I thought it would be good to remind the Brethren of our Anchor & Ark symbols.



The anchor is used a lot in Christian symbolism and has been adopted by Freemasons to have a similar meaning. It represents hope, as well as peace against stormy weather.

An anchor is used, quite literally, as a way of grounding a ship, and in the same way this symbol talks about living a life that is grounded in hope and peace.

The Ark (like Noah's Ark) signifies life's journey and with the Anchor representing steadfast hope and divine grounding that leads to eternal peace and helps to provide a safe passage through life's troubles.
