



Trestle & Tracing boards



Some of Freemasonry's oldest symbols were first found on Masonic trestle and tracing boards. Originally used to present construction plans to apprentice stonemasons in the Middle Ages, these ancient practices were adopted in early Freemasonry to securely share the "blueprint" of our Craft with candidates.
