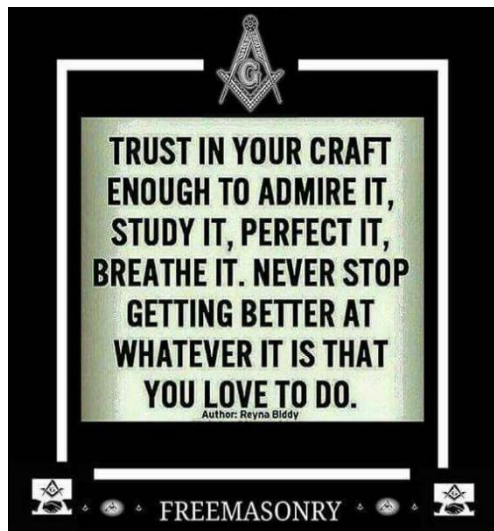

47TH Problem of Euclid



The 47th Problem of Euclid, also known as the Pythagorean Theorem states that the sum of the areas of the two squares on the legs of a right triangle equals the area of the square on the hypotenuse. In Masonry it is symbolic of mathematical precision, the synthesis of arts & sciences, moral integrity & the need to 'square your square'. In everyday practice, this means to keep your life in order. It is associated with the Past Master's Jewel and serves as a vital tool for establishing right angles in construction.
