Tryout Information

This packet includes tryout information for rising sixth, seventh, and eighth grade students in the Harrison High School District that are interested in cheering for the Harrison Junior Hoya Cheer Program (HJCP).

Tryout Registration Drop Off:

April 9th - 5 to 6pm @ Burnt Hickory Baptist Church in the Children's Lobby (back parking lot)

There will not be an informational tryout meeting this year. Registration Packet and \$50 tryout fee will be turned in at Burnt Hickory Baptist Church in the back Children's Lobby any time between 5pm and 6pm. Please review the tryout information in this packet including squad rules/expectations, tryout requirements, and other important information.

Specific tryout information will be sent out via email the week of tryouts. This email will include your cheerleader's tryout time and number.

*Parents will be notified the evening of April 16th if your prospective competition cheerleader will need to return on the 17th.

Tryout Location:

Harrison High School - Small Gym

Cheer candidates must be dropped off at the gym entrance in the bus port, where they will sign in and get their tryout number in the lobby. This is a closed tryout and <u>parents are not needed</u> <u>for check in</u>.

Tryout Dress Code:

- Cheer shorts with NO LOGO'S (navy or black)
- Solid white t-shirt with NO LOGO'S (no embroidery, prints, etc.)
- Hair up in a high pony with a solid white bow (NO LOGO'S)
- White cheer/athletic shoes with no show white socks
- No jewelry



Tryout Information

Instructional Videos:

There will be NO instructional clinic this year. All instructional material will be available virtually on the website. The video for the dance will be available April 11th. The videos for the cheer and chant will be available April 13th. Cheerleaders will be responsible for teaching themselves the cheer, chant, and dance given the instructional videos.

Iryout:

Cheerleaders will perform the tryout cheer, chant, and dance in front of a judge who will be recording a video. Candidates will be judged on jumps (toe touch and one optional jump), motion technique, knowledge, appearance, spirit, and skill. Candidates trying out for the Competition squad will be judged on tumbling. Tumbling is required for competition with a minimum of a back handspring, but we are looking for higher level tumbling skills as well. Cheerleaders will try out one at a time, not in groups.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for tryouts, cheer candidates must reside in the Harrison High School (HHS) attendance zone, or be eligible to attend a HHS feeder school according to the Cobb County Board of Education Attendance policies.

Sideline Squads:

The Junior Hoya Cheer Program consists of 3 sideline squads: 6^{th} , 7^{th} , and 8^{th} grade. Each squad size will be selected based on scoring scales. Size will vary based on the talent level of each group's candidates. Sideline squads will support its corresponding athletic teams during the entire football season including playoffs. Sideline squads will practice once a week (Tuesdays) and cheer at the Saturday football games during the 2024 season. There will be one mandatory Choreography Camp during the summer (June $11^{th} - 12^{th}$). There will also be multiple practices and team bonding activities over the summer.

Competition Squad:

The Junior Hoya Cheer Program has one competition squad consisting of 6^{th} , 7^{th} , and 8^{th} grade cheerleaders. The squad size will vary based on talent and skill levels assessed at tryouts and is determined by the competition coach. **A back handspring is a minimum requirement to be considered for the competition squad**. We are looking for higher level tumbling as well. Tumbling will be evaluated at tryouts. The competition squad will practice twice a week and participate in competitions on Saturdays and Sundays during the 2024 season. There will be a mandatory Choreography Camp during the summer (July $17^{th} - 18^{th}$) in addition to two weekly practices.

Tryout Results:

Tryout results will be sent via Remind on April 23rd by 5:00pm. Each cheer candidate will receive a text message with the list of candidates, by tryout number, that were selected for each squad. Make sure to sign up for the Junior Hoya Cheer Tryout Remind (text @jrhoyato24 to 81010).



Requirements for Tryouts

- 1. Fill out and submit the Harrison Junior Hoya Cheer Tryout Survey, found on our website https://hoyajrcheer.webstarts.com.
- 2. Sign up for the Tryout Remind Group: text @jrhoyato24 to 81010
- 3. You must complete and sign all forms included in the **Junior Hoya Cheer Registration Packet** (found on our website). These forms are to be turned in on Tuesday, April 9th.
 Drop off will be at BHBC in the back Children's Lobby from 5 to 6pm.
- 4. You must submit the \$50 **non-refundable** tryout fee with the registration packet. Make check payable to HJCBC.
- 5. You must submit a copy of ParentVue showing Q3 grades. Cheerleaders are expected to maintain high academic and behavior standards. Candidates must be passing all classes and have a conduct grade of "S" or higher.
- Cheer candidates must obtain <u>two</u> teacher recommendations. Teacher recommendation form is found on our website https://hoyajrcheer.webstarts.com.
 Cheerleaders must provide their teacher with the website link. Recommendations are filled out electronically. Teacher recommendations are due April 9th.
- 7. Summer vacation plans need to be emailed to Laura James & Ni'Cole McCrae by April 9th. These are confirmed vacations that will result in your cheerleader being absent at any point this summer. Your cheerleader is expected to be at every summer practice unless excused by the emailed vacation plans. Dead Weeks are May 27th 31st and July 1st 5th. We will not practice during Dead Weeks.
- 8. Guardians of selected cheerleaders must attend the Booster Club meeting on April 30th.

Required Physical

All cheerleaders selected for the 2024 cheer season must have a current physical.

Each cheerleader is required to have a Medical Release/Physical Form on file for the upcoming season and should be dated no earlier than June 4th, 2023 (must be current within a year). This form must be completed, signed by an M.D. or D.O. and turned in to your Team mom by June 4th (for sideline cheerleaders) or June 5th (for competition only cheerleaders). You CANNOT begin practice, go to camp or participate in any cheerleading activity without a physical on file with Harrison Junior Cheerleading Board. Physical forms are available on the website.
