

Need to Know:

Do (thumbs to chest)

What's Right (two thumbs up)

Bible Story:

Joseph Learns to Do What's Right Genesis 37, 39:1-6

Materials per Group:

- Pocket Die
 - Traveling Pictures (in each pocket)
- Bible Story Cards
- Colored Sample Plate
- Crayons
 - o Red
 - o **Green**
- Leader Card
- Hand Sanitizer
- Remember Verse
 Card

Materials per Child:

- Small Paper Plates(1)
- Snacks (1)
- Coloring Sheets (1)
- Extra ColoringSheets (1)

Get Their Attention! (4 minutes)

Materials: Pocket Die (with Traveling Pictures in each pocket)

WELCOME kids and **INTRODUCE** yourself to the group as their leader. Then **EXPLAIN** that we are all going to pretend to travel in time here in Dr. Tock's Clock Workshop.

ROLL the **Pocket Die** to each child. Have the child **SAY** his/her name aloud and **SHOW** the **Traveling Picture** that is on the **TOP** of the **pocket die** to the group.

READ aloud the question on the **Traveling Picture**, and have the child **RESPOND**.

After all kids have been introduced, SAY:

- You did a great job DOING WHAT'S RIGHT (two thumbs up) and helping us know more about you!
- ① Today we are going to learn more about a person in the Bible whose name is JOSEPH. (Pronounced: Joe-sehf) Can you say "Joseph"?

What The Bible Says (5 minutes)

Materials: Bible Story Cards

SHOW and READ the Bible Story Cards.

Make It Matter (6 minutes)

Materials: Colored Sample Plate, Small Paper Plates, Crayons (Red, Green), Leader Card

- 1. **EXPLAIN** that we're going to make something with paper plates to help us learn how to STOP (show **RED** side of Sample Plate) doing wrong things and GO (show GREEN side of Sample Plate) **DO WHAT'S RIGHT** (show thumbs up).
- 2. GIVE each child ONE Small Paper Plate.
- 3. Allow kids to **COLOR** one side of the **plate** RED and the other side of the **plate** GREEN.
- READ aloud each statement/question from the Leader Card and have kids HOLD UP the correct side of their plate (red or green).
- 5. Then SAY:

God wants us to do what's right by being kind and showing love to others!

If you can do what's right, let me hear you say this after me: (have kids repeat after you)

Do (thumbs to chest) **What's Right** (two thumbs up)

Need to Know:

Do

(thumbs to chest)

What's Right (two thumbs up)

Remember Verse:

"Love (hug self)

Being kind (pat heart)

To others." (point to others)

Micah 6:8 (hands open, like a book)

Wrap It Up (5 minutes)

Materials: Hand Sanitizer, Snacks, Remember Verse Card, Crayons, Coloring Sheets

PRAY with your group, having them repeat after you in short phrases.

SANITIZE hands with hand sanitizer and PASS OUT snacks.

EXPLAIN and PRACTICE the series Remember Verse using the Remember Verse Card.

As kids are eating, allow them to COLOR their Coloring Sheets and discuss what they learned today.

Have Extra Time?

Materials: Pocket Die, Colored Sample Plate, Crayons, Extra Coloring Sheets

DO any of the following activities to keep kids engaged for the remainder of small group.

- Pocket Die: PLAY the "Get Their Attention" Game again.
 - Option: Have kids tell you what they would take with them if they were traveling to the Traveling Picture shown
- Play STOP and GO: Lead kids in playing a game similar to "Red Light, Green Light". USE the Colored Sample Plate to SHOW kids when to stop and go.
 - Option: Have kids STOP when you say an action or statement that is NOT an example of Doing What's Right. When you say an action/statement that IS Doing What's Right, allow them to GO and dance/shake/get wiggles out.
- SING: TEACH kids the following song to help them remember what we learned today. SAY/SING each line and have kids REPEAT after you.

(To the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb")

God wants me to do what's right (Mary had a little lamb)

Do what's right (Little lamb)

Do what's right (Little lamb)

God wants me to do what's right (Mary had a little lamb)

And He will help me to. (Its fleece was white as snow)

- Extra Coloring Sheet: Allow kids to COLOR the Extra Coloring Sheets, as time and attention spans allow.
- **Get To Know Your Group: ASK** any of the following to get to know your group.
 - o If you could travel to anywhere in the world, where would you go?
 - What is one way you can Do What's Right at home? On the playground? At church? At school?
 - o Did you have fun today?
 - o What did you learn at church today?
