Thanks to the vision of the 9 original board members back in 1996 and the generosity of 38 donors who have been proudly named as the CACF Founder's Club, the CACF has been able to grant a total of \$856,887 to worthy local organizations in Carberry and area or as scholarships to local Carberry

Collegiate graduating students over the past 20 years.

The CACF has gone from being able to grant \$4,258 in their first granting year to now having \$113,000 available to grant!

Endowments are at \$2.55 million which is remarkable for a small community like Carberry and area!

The current CACF board thought it fitting to celebrate their 20th anniversary with coffee and cake and announcements at the official

opening of the Carberry Fair July 2, 2016. Festivities start at 1 PM and will go until 7 PM.

CACF Board members reached out to the Founder's Club and past board members encouraging their presence at the celebration.

Youth in Philanthropy (YiP)

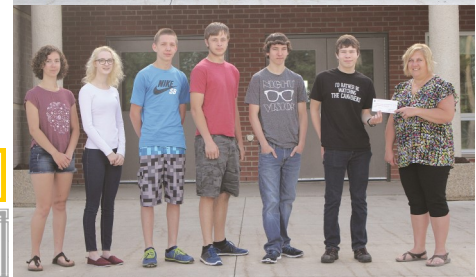
