

SUPPLY LISTS & FEES

- 1) Below is a list of *cleaning supplies* needed for all enrolled children, due annually in August, or upon enrollment. (For ages 0-12 yrs)

- 2) There is **ALSO** a \$75.00 Enrollment Fee due for all children, due annually in August, or upon enrollment. (For ages 0-5 yrs)



*** Cleaning Supplies and Enrollment Fees are due annually in August, or upon enrollment, and are not eligible for reimbursement in case of withdrawal.**

Children need to bring a jacket/sweater whenever you feel is appropriate for outside play. As per state regulations, any child who is not well enough to participate in activities, including outside play, should not be in attendance at the center. Please see our Illness Policy.

4) CHILD PERSONAL ITEMS

A. *Below is a list of personal items that must be brought in for all enrolled children, ages 1-5*
Parents, please label all personal items with child's First Name and Last Initial.

** 12 months-5 yrs*

Tote bag	Toothbrush
Small blanket	Toothbrush cover (needed for health inspections)
Regular-sized towel (to be used as a pillow)	Toothpaste
Toddler nap mat	Hair brush (for girls)
Change of clothes (placed inside a large ziplock bag) {should include socks, bottom, top, and underwear (if applicable)}	

Each hair brush is kept in a ziplock bag, so as to be kept separately from each other.

B. *A Large Plastic bib with a pocket is needed for all children, ages 1-2 years, to be kept at the center. Plastic bibs are easy for us to clean for reuse throughout the day.*

** 12 months-2 yrs*

Lg Plastic bib with pocket (no cloth bibs)

C. *Diapering Supplies*

** If applicable:*

Diapers or Pull-ups (at least 2-week supply)

Wipes (at least 2-week supply)

Baby powder or diaper cream

**Please note that we do change diapers/pull-ups several times throughout the day.*

All diapering supplies are clearly labeled and not shared with any other child.

As we may assist parents in potty-training, we are not able to do the initial potty-training process. The initial process requires hours of individual time with the child in the restroom, and our caregivers are not able to leave the other children unattended during that long period of time. We may, however, continue the process that is working for you so that your child can continue to be successful.

Due to health reasons, we are not able to accept children in underwear who are potty-training until they are ready. Pull-ups are best until the child has begun to go to the potty successfully.

D. *Infant Supplies*
