Best Practices

These tips and tricks have been gathered to make completing the application process easier for all involved. When in doubt, reach out to National Pageant Director Alexandria Cerveny Sandall with any questions!

1 When filling out the biographical section of the application (first part) list your name as you would like it to be in the program and all publications. Additionally, only parent(s) name(s) included on the application be used in materials.

2 USPS and FedEx work swell for mailing application. Requiring a signature for delivering doesn't work as well.

3 Use a paperclip to bind your application together, it makes processing applications easier!

4 Email your Kroj Description (Word format) to National Pageant Director Alex when you send your application. Additionally include a note if your application fee will be sent in from your State Pageant Director. This saves on back-and-forth emails.

5 Spellcheck is your friend! Double and triple check your application before submitting it that you are following all the formatting guidelines and that all pages are included.

6 Please select a headshot that does not include your crown and sash.

7 Please print the kroj documentation photos on paper instead of taping pictures to a page or sending them in loose. Also include your source citation. This greatly assists the judges in reviewing your documents.
