

(7) The foot rest and yolk were designed by me and made by Bony (see earlier salutation). The foot rest was crafted from two 1 by 6 by 30-inch oak planks. The foot rest is fitted on the longitudinal rails in the bottom of the boat. Each rail has five evenly-spaced holes drilled to fit a key, which locks the foot rest in a comfortable leg-length for the oars-person. Each exposed surface is covered with a strip of sand-paper, which keeps the feet from slipping off the foot rest.
