Welcome to 2026! Our Sunday school team is ready to kick-off the new year with classes on January 11th and 25th, starting at 9:45am.

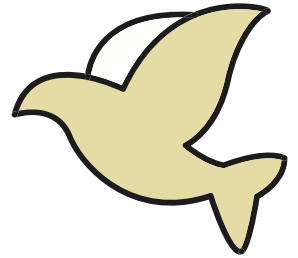
The Adult Class will continue their study of the Book of Acts. Please consider joining them for this informative and lively time of discussion as they look at the activities of the early church.

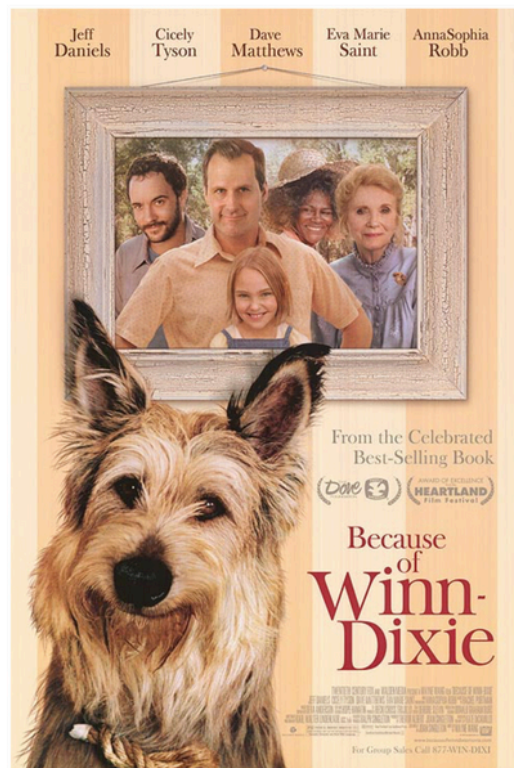




PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN

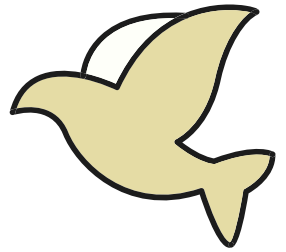

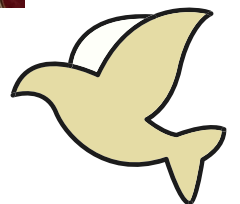
