2024 Show Committee Report

Our spring 2024 Daffodil Show is entitled *And Dances with the Daffodils*. The show will include horticulture, photography and three floral displays, courtesy of the Halten, Hardy and Woodbrook- Murray Hill Garden Clubs. Inspired by William Wordsworth's beautiful poem "I Wandered Lonely as a Cloud" this year's theme informs the photography classes as well as our MDS Garden Club Floral Displays. ADS Judging School Being Offered

The Maryland Daffodil Society is pleased to sponsor a daffodil judging school beginning in 2024.

It's a three-year process to become an accredited American Daffodil Society judge. School I will be held on Wednesday, April 3, 2024 at the Greenhouse Classroom at Cylburn Arboretum. We encourage anyone who wants basic daffodil knowledge to take this one-day class. You can decide to take the test to become a judge at the end of the class, or just attend for your own benefit. We will offer judging school courses II and III in 2025 and 2026.

Judges Accreditation Requirements are:

- 1. Hold a current membership with the ADS.
- 2. Pass all the ADS judging schools with a score of at least 75% in each section of the school.
- 3. Grow at least 100 different daffodil cultivars, species and miniatures from at least eight divisions.
- Serve as a student judge at three or more ADS approved shows with a favorable evaluation from the Accredited Judge who supervised the experience.
- 5. Exhibit daffodils in ADS approved shows for at least three years.
- 6. Win at least five blue ribbons over the course of three years in ADS approved shows. One blue ribbon needs to be for a collection. A red or yellow ribbon with 90+ score is acceptable.

The cost of Judging School I is \$25.00, and will cover snacks, lunch and costs associated with conducting the class. Interested? Please email or call the class registrar, Julie Minch, julesmin@gmail.com, 410-303-6536.
