The ADS 2025 Wister Award is presented to 'Cassata'. This Split-Cupped Collar daffodil is outstanding in the garden and well deserving of this award. N. 'Cassata' was registered 1963, hybridized by Gerritsen and Son from the Netherlands, and is included in the ADS Classics special class. The perianth segments are very broadly ovate, greenish white and reflexed, with a corona split to base and closely overlying the perianth segments. An early to mid-season bloomer, it is lightly scented, and long lasting.

Maryland Daffodil Society Hosts American Daffodil Society Judges School II

The Maryland Daffodil Society will host the ADS Judges School II on Thursday, April 17, 2025. There are a few requirements for taking the course. A copy of the handbook "Growing, Exhibiting and Judging Daffodils", 6th edition 2020, will be needed. It can be purchased via the American Daffodil Society website store at https://daffodilusa.org. Please read the sections for School II prior to attending.

Please plan to arrive the night before for the school. You will be able to see the blooms you will need to study for the ID part of the test. As stated in the handbook, the course is broken down into 3 sections lasting a total of 4 hours of lecture and then testing time. There will be a display of 30 blooms and the test requires identifying 20 or more. You will have time to study these the night before and the morning of the school. The three schools can be taken in any order.

The cost of the school is \$35.00. Snacks and lunch will be provided.

Interested in spending the night? Delta Hotels by Marriott - Baltimore North, 5100 Falls Road, Baltimore, MD 21210 (410.532.6900 main number), is nearby.

The class will be held in the Greenhouse Classroom at Cylburn Arboretum, 4915 Greenspring Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21209. Plan to allow time to tour the Arboretum grounds; they have a beautiful display of thousands of daffodils. Directions are below.

Minutes of the 2024 Fall Meeting of the Maryland Daffodil Society The Meeting took place on Saturday, November 2, 2024 at the Greenhouse Classroom at Cylburn Arboretum, 4915 Greenspring Ave., Baltimore, MD 21209, and was called to order by President Muffin
McAfee at 1:45 PM. 33 persons were present. Minutes of the 2023 Fall Meeting were approved as printed in the March and October 2024 newsletters.
Treasurer's Report (detailed report filed with Minutes). Jackie Handley presented the following:
Beginning balance 9/30/23 \$17,156.49 Expenses through 9/30/24 (12,454.26)
Income through 9/30/24 5,007.00 Ending balance 9/30/24 \$ 9,709.23
Certificate of Deposit of \$5,339.33 renewed for 6 months, to next mature 1/7/25.
<u>President's Report:</u> Muffin welcomed attendees, thanked her fellow 2024 Show Committee members Sherry Jordan, Catherine Max, Meredith McDonagh, Pat Parker and Sally Waller, floral arrangers from Halten, Hardy and Woodbrook-Murray Hill Garden Clubs, and over 50 volunteers for a successful 2024 show. There were 437 entries and 774 blooms. She thanked Julie and Paul Minch for managing the MDS website, and Debbig
Cameron and Olivia Welbourn for coordinating today's bulb sale.
Muffin summarized MDS achievements over the past 4 years, including innovative activities during the Covid pandemic.
Muffin introduced Julie Minch, ADS Mid Atlantic Regional Vice-President, who reported no winner of the Mid-Atlantic Leadership and Service
Award, as no nominations were received.
Committee Reports:
• Membership. Chair Julie Minch reported that before today, 19 persons and 8 garden clubs paid dues for 2024 – 2025.
• MDS Show Committee. Muffin reported that a committee consisting of herself, Catherine Max, Meredith McDonagh, Pat Parker and Sally Waller will chair the 2025 show. This will be MDS's 100 th show, and will be held Wednesday April 16 - Thursday April 17, 2025, again at the Vollmer Center at Cylburn Arboretum. Set-up will be on Tuesday, April 15. The Committee hopes to offer a competitive Design Division. Clean boxwood is wanted for staging, as are volunteers for Passing, Pages, Clerks and Hostesses, with extra hands requested for Dismantling. A sign-up sheet was circulated.
 Awards. Sally Waller presented the T. McKean-Meiere Award, given to the winner of the most weighted points in horticulture and the oldest MDS Award, to Kate Carney for her entries in the 2024 MDS Show.
• Nominating Committee. Prior to hearing the report of the Committee, Muffin introduced Deana Kozak, nominee for President, ADS Judge former ADS Regional VP and member of Dorchester Garden Club, as well as Mary Carol Bruff, nominee for Vice-President, avid arranger, former banker and Girl Scout leader, and member of Glen Arm Garden Club.
Chair Pat Parker presented the slate of nominees for 2024 – 2026: Deana Kozak, President; Mary Carol Bruff, Vice-President; Susan Palmer, Secretary; Jackie Handley, Treasurer. There were no nominations from the floor.
MOTION TO APPROVE THE SLATE OF OFFICERS AS PRESENTED was made by Nancy Johnston and seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Outgoing Board Members-at-Large Leslie Aronson, Debbie Cameron, Sherry Jordan, Pat Ghingher and Mary Ann Thompson were recognized. Incoming Members-at-Large Kathie Offutt, Pat Parker, Reiko Royston, Sally Waller, Hilles Whedbee and Liz Williams were welcomed. Deana Kozak made introductory remarks and reminded of the April 10 – April 13, 2025 ADS National Convention at the Peppermill Resort and Casino, Reno, NV, hosted by the High Desert Daffodil Society.
New Business:
• ADS Judges School. Julie Minch announced that ADS Judges School Course II will be held Thursday, April 17, 2025, in the Greenhouse Classroom at Cylburn.
The business meeting adjourned at 2:09 PM. Kathy Welsh, ADS Judge, past president of both ADS and Washington Daffodil Society, ADS Board member for the past 33 years, and recipient of the ADS Silver medal in 2024 presented an informative program entitled "How, When and Where to Plant Daffodils for Show".
