The University Guest House (UGH) at University of Utah Guest House Hotel and Conference Center (universityguesthouse.com) has been home to us for many Annual Conference meetings, and we're coming back to Salt Lake City! This venue has very convenient and modern facilities, including an elegantly furnished Chapel, ideal for our group's size. It is located in the historic and scenic district of Fort Douglas, directly east of the 2002 Olympic Legacy Bridge.

For room assignments, however, the UGH can accommodate only 30 guests due to on-going improvements. The Guest House has arranged accommodations for 50 rooms with the Marriott University Park, located $\frac{3}{4}$ mile away from the UGH. Shuttle service is included in this arrangement. Room rates will be the same for both. Notice will be sent to you via email and the NCVACC website when the reservation period would begin. You will then have the option of choosing where to stay, while rooms are available.

In a few weeks, you will be receiving the conference packet by email and the website. This will include, among other things, the following: (1) Letter of Archbishop Timothy Broglio, JCD, with instructions to all Catholic priests employed at the VA; (2) Conference Education Schedule and ITT; (3) Registration Form; and (4) Membership Forms for Renewal and New Application. Members have until June 30, 2022 to avail of the discount by paying their dues.

Each VA Health Care System may have varying requirements and forms for travel, training and other related activities. It is recommended that you start to determine what these are early enough.
