

# PRAYING FOR DELIVERANCE

40 Days of Prayer – Part 5

October 11, 2020

**Matthew 6:13** - "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."

**Romans 7:15-24** – "I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. . . <sup>19</sup>For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing. . . <sup>24</sup>What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death?"

**I Corinthians 10:13** – "No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it."

## Pathway of Escape

1. Identify our areas of \_\_\_\_\_ .

**Matthew 26:41** – "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak."

**2. Make an \_\_\_\_\_ how to fend off temptation.**

**Proverbs 4:26-27** – “Give careful thought to the paths for your feet and be steadfast in all your ways. <sup>27</sup> Do not turn to the right or the left; keep your foot from evil.”

**3. Redirect our \_\_\_\_\_ .**

Redirecting our thoughts toward God’s Word keeps us from succumbing to temptation and doing foolish things, because when we focus on God’s commands it gets our minds off the dumb stuff we could be doing.

Example of Jesus - Matthew 4:1-11

**Philippians 4:8** – “Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.”

**4. Pray for \_\_\_\_\_ .**

**Matthew 6:13** (Emphasis added) - “And lead us not into temptation but **DELIVER US** from the evil one.”

**Psalms 50:15** - “Call on me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me.”
