

The capital city of Canada is Ottawa, which is located in the province of Ontario. It stands on the south bank of the Ottawa river in the eastern portion of southern Ontario. Ottawa is Canada's fourth largest city with a population exceeding more than 900,000 residents. This city was selected by Queen Victoria as the capital in mid-19th century. The city name "Ottawa" was chosen in reference to the Ottawa River nearby, the name of which is derived from the Algonquin Odawa, meaning "to trade".
