After this, they drop the candy in the stocking and then race back to the next person in line and give them the spoon. First team, who fills the stocking, wins the game.

Candy Cane Pass is one more Christmas game that you can arrange for the entertaining your kids. According to the rules of this game, each team is provided with four candy canes. The first player of the team holds all the four candy canes between his/her fingers and then passes them teammate to teammate without dropping any one of them. The team with the maximum number of members passing these candy canes successfully to each other is claimed as the winning team.
