As of Monday, March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, Toronto and Peel was subject to an amendment on certain restrictions. Churches are now permitted a **15 per cent maximum capacity** for sacramental celebrations, which is a significant improvement from the 10 people maximum that had been in place for several months.

# Our Church's Re-Opening Mass Times:

- ➤ <u>Weekday Masses</u> will resume on Thursday, March 17<sup>th</sup> **Monday to Friday at 9:00am**
- ➤ Weekend Masses will resume on the weekend of March 20<sup>th</sup>/21<sup>st</sup> with the following schedule:

Saturday 5:00pm English

Sunday 8:00am English 12:00pm English 10:00am Italian 2:00pm Tamil

At this time there will be NO PUBLIC DEVOTIONS before or after any Masses (e.g., Rosary)

## **DISPENSATION FROM OUR SUNDAY OBLIGATION**

Cardinal Collins continues to dispense Catholics from our Sunday obligations. Therefore, if you are not feeling well, have a pre-existing condition, or are considered to be in a high risk category, then we respectfully ask you to continue to experience church in your home through virtual Mass and personal devotions. ## REGARDING MASS DURING A TIME OF PANDEMIC

**Please Note...** A member of each household is required to <u>SIGN IN</u> their family when they arrive at the entrance of the church in order to comply with contact tracing protocols. Parishioners are asked to <u>BRING THEIR OWN PENS</u>. Hand-sanitizer will be available at the sign-in stations.

- Complying with social distancing regulation, the seating capacity at Our Lady of the Airways Parish is limited to <u>56 designated spots</u> (households), or a <u>maximum of 150 people</u> within the church.
- Mass attendance at our parish will be on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS.
- Parishioners will be required to <u>line up at the front main entrances of the church</u>
- The church doors will open 30 MINUTES BEFORE DESIGNATED MASS TIMES.
- Health officials have expressed concern regarding the faithful congregating in or around the church before and after services in large numbers. We ask you <u>NOT TO CONGREGATE/SOCIALIZE IN</u> <u>THE FOYER OR PARKING LOT</u> and please <u>always practice physical distancing</u> (whether you are inside/outside the church).

## **GUIDELINES FOR RETURNING TO THE CHURCH**

## **COVID19 PROTOCOLS**

The following physical distancing, sanitizing, and safety protocols have been put in place. Please adhere to these protocols for your good and the good of your neighbour.

- Please take a temperature check before leaving for church. If you have the slightest fever, or are feeling sick, please stay at home.
- Please wear a mask/face covering (for everyone over the age of three) and keep it on the entire time you are at the church. A mask will be provided if you need one.
- Please sanitize your hands at the marked sanitizing stations found at the entrance of the church.
- Once you have been directed to your designated pew, you are expected to remain seated until you exit
  the church.

## **CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARIST**

- Please listen carefully to announcements before the start of Mass. Follow direction as advised.
- Parishioners attending Mass are asked <u>NOT TO SING</u> at this time to minimize the potential spread of the virus. Singing provides a significant opportunity for the projection of particles from the mouth.
- There will be <u>NO OFFERTORY</u> collection. Please leave donations in the designated basket upon departure as directed.
- We ask that people do not hold hands or shake hands during any portion of the celebration of the Eucharist. At the Sign of Peace, a nod or bow to others is appropriate.
- During this time of pandemic and under the guidance of local medical health officials, the faithful are asked <u>TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION IN THE HAND</u> by placing one on top of the other, allowing the Eucharistic Minister to safely place the Body of Christ in one's hand without contact.
- Masks/face coverings should be removed prior to reception of Holy Communion and put back on after consumption.
- Follow direction for communion flow ensuring physical distancing at all times.
- Following Mass, please depart the church so that cleaning may commence.

## **GENERAL**

- If you suddenly feel ill, start coughing or sneezing, please leave the church for the health and safety of others gathered.
- If, within 14 days of attending Mass, you learn that you or someone in your family who attended Mass with you has tested positive for COVID-19, you are asked to: a) contact the Ontario Public Health Authority; and, b) contact the parish office. Your identity will not be revealed to anyone other than the Public Health Authority, and only to ensure that any spread is contained.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT THE WASHROOMS WILL REMAIN CLOSED. In case of an emergency, please approach an usher or a volunteer.

Weddings, funerals, and baptisms will still take place (with specific restrictions for each celebration). Confessions will continue to be available by appointment only. Please call the office to set an appointment with a priest.

#### **PARISH OFFICE**

The parish office will remain closed to the public as per the directives of Public Health. We continue to check emails and voicemails on a daily basis.
