

THE UNIVERSAL CODES

SECTION 1

Questions: Why am I on this planet? What am I supposed to be doing? How do I make life more inspiring, fulfilling, and harmonious? Did you find out the answer, or are you walking around here like cattle that are in a herd, following anything that is given to you, being oblivious to this matrix, the planet, life, or how anything in the universe works? Well, there is a practical approach to dealing with these questions with the universal codes.

One needs purpose and objectives in life and ways to obtain them, or one will be in a continuous loop, failing to move to the next phase of existence. One should have a method and a system to live in society and not just be running around in this reality being oblivious with no direction in their existence. The Universal Codes (TUC) is a concept that creates a way to deal with the workings of this physical matrix of reality. The Universal Codes recognize that everything and everyone is moving (that is, vibrating), and everything and everyone is energy. To help one deal with this matrix reality, it is revealed in the concepts of The Universal Codes (TUC), GEEDology, and PEEMology.

SECTION 2: THE ALL

The All says that everything is energy/spirit, and everything is part of the All. It cannot be anything that exists outside of the All. If it did, then it would become part of the All when one became aware of its

existence. That which is outside of the All, is combined with the rest of the All, which would be equal to the All or the new All. Being part of the All is what makes everything connected and part of the whole.

The energy of the All flows through everything in reality in a quantum way, creating life force energy from the source.

If there is nothing outside of All—or how could it exist?—one could say that existence is consciousness (awareness) vibrating at many levels and frequencies. The All is conscious and vibration, and conscious and vibration are the foundation for The Universal Codes.

SECTION 3: THE THREE CODES

The Universal Codes is a concept that creates a way to deal with this reality and understand the workings of this physical matrix. The TUC concept is based on these three codes:

The first code of The Universal Codes is **The Code of Conscious**, conscious is **first cause**. How your consciousness is aligned is how energy will flow through you. Energy is neutral; it is how a vessel is configured that the energy flows through that determines the outcome of the energy. If you have negative energy within you, then you will get negative energy and unbalanced results. It is up to you to stay positive for positive outcomes. People must find different ways to help themselves stay positive. This is how you take the responsibility of creating your reality—by how you configure your conscious and mindset.

Consciousness is power; that is, it is a type of mental awareness that is present for you to make use of. Does something exist if one is not conscious of it? If one were having a hard time performing a task and then became aware that it was a much easier way to accomplish the

same task, then one would understand that consciousness can be powerful when expanded. One must put effort into expanding consciousness by seeking knowledge. The less knowledge one has, the more limitations one has. The more information one has, the more knowledge one has to be creative with.

Energy is just energy...one's configuration will determine what outcome one will get. When electric energy comes through a plug, it doesn't know whether it is a TV, computer, or lamp....so it is the same when the force comes through you; it intensifies who you are. Your purpose and objectives in life is to give the energy directions for progress.

The second code, **The Code of Vibration**, is **first principle**, which is that everything is in motion; everything vibrates; nothing is at rest.

Everything in the universe is constantly moving. The stars and planets are rotating and spinning while galaxies are expanding....while trees are growing, their leaves fall in the autumn and new ones grow in the spring. The universe and nature are in motion (vibrating). This motion leads everything to grow, develop, expand, and evolve. When anything stops moving or vibrating, its energy becomes stagnated, and then it will age, start to decay, or fall behind. For example, take water; when it is moving, it stays fresh, but let water stay still for a long period of time, and it will become stale. A business that does not grow will have a hard time competing in the market, or a person that does not develop will fall behind in society. This principle of movement can apply to people, businesses, organizations, or anything in society. If you stop maintaining your body, it will start to create an unbalanced effect of deterioration, the same with your mental body, your emotional body, and your subjective self.

This understanding of the movement of energy is the foundation of The Codes of The Universe. Movements are not sporadic or haphazard, but there is an order to them—what one might call cycles, phases, ages, periods, and so on. Understanding these stages helps one to keep track of and deal with the movement of energy.

This flow, expansion, and movement of energy in the universe is constant and stops for no one....so it might be more beneficial to flow with the current. That is, as these cycles come and go, try to move up to other levels of growth and development, or you will stagnate.

We are part of the All, in an expanding universe, and this source of energy flows through us. We are a vessel for the energy to flow through, and the more we expand and progress, the more life force energy is created. The universe continues to expand in this physical reality through us and our creations. The universe creates technology, systems, and societies through us. However, how we create reality is up to us; we can **choose to create in harmony** and love with everyone working together for a better society **or choose disharmony**.

The third code, **The Code of Preservation**, is **first law**. The concept of self-preservation was explained in the text titled Spiritual Autonomy. For now, the focus of this code is how one might approach their continued existence. The concepts of GEEDology and SPEEMology will provide a method for self-preservation later on in other sections.

SECTION 4: THE FIVE PRINCIPLES

There are five universal principles that guide the workings of the code of vibration. Here is a brief look at these five principles:

1. THE PRINCIPLE OF CORRESPONDENCE

The principle of correspondence is as above, so below; as below, so above. Your inner self corresponds to your outer self; your higher self corresponds to your lower self; and your subconscious corresponds to your conscious. What is projected into your higher self (subjective realm) is what you create, even your linear mind when it is unconsciously thinking.

The best way to analyze what is going on with you is to find out what is in your conscious and what has been projected to your subconscious. The subconscious has blockages that you might not be aware of that could have been programmed there since you were a child. For example, if you wonder why you have issues with money, then subconsciously you might associate money with negative behavior. If you do not consciously create what is in your subconscious, then it will run on default and be programmed by others in the outer world.

2. THE PRINCIPLE OF POLARITY

The principle of polarity is that everything is dual; everything has two poles, and everything has a pair of opposites. Heat and cold are really the same things that are different in degrees.

To really know something is to know its opposite. If you went outside every day and it was hot at 90°F, that would be a normal condition, and you would not even think about it. Let's say that you went outside one day and it was 25°F and you started shaking and freezing from the cold. Through that experience, you would know what it was like to be hot by experiencing and understanding the condition of the cold, which is the opposite of hot.

In polarity, you want to always seek balance and not extremes. Everyone is not the same, so everyone's balance will not be the same. When there are extremes, it is a warning that something is not in balance. It is okay to be sad or happy, but after a long period of time, it becomes unbalanced. Being sad for too long could leave you with depression or stress, and being over happy for too long could leave you with disillusion; always thinking that everything is okay becomes naïve, making it easier for society to take advantage of you.

3. THE PRINCIPLE OF CAUSE AND EFFECT

The principle of cause and effect is that every cause has its effect, and every effect has its cause. When a principle is not recognized or one does not understand the reason for an event, they would say that it is about chance.

Everything you do, say, and think registers in the subconscious and the universe and has an effect on you. It is good that you can affect things, but it works both ways—to the positive and to the negative. When things happen to us, good or bad, we are conscious or mostly unconscious, causing them to happen rather than taking responsibility for them or not. It is easy to blame somebody or something else. If someone wins some money, then we say they were lucky, but if something bad happens, well, you can always blame some evil force.

You can only receive what you put out; reap what you sow. If you say that you love everyone but don't show love toward certain groups of people, then your actions and vibrations are what the universe records, not your words. You can fool people with your words. But if they pick up on your energy field, then they will know your inner vibration.

4. THE PRINCIPLE OF GENDER

The principle of gender is that everything has its masculine and feminine principle; it's the principle of creation and generation—the tree of life and the tree of knowledge; yin and yang.

The masculine is when the energy is active, while the feminine is when the energy is passive. Active energy is weak and unbalanced if it is forceful or unproductive, and strong when energetic and influencing. Passive energy does not mean being weak and not productive. Passive is strong when it is creative and inspiring. Some people respond better when there is a more masculine direct hands-on approach, while others respond better when there is a more passive indirect information-gathering approach.

When you bring the two principles together, you can produce. You can take all the action without knowing how and not be productive, or you can possess all the knowledge and creativity and still get nowhere if you do not take action.

5. THE PRINCIPLE OF RHYTHM

The principle of rhythm is that everything flows out and in; everything rises and falls; the pendant swing to the left will equal the swing to the right; everything vibrates at a frequency.

There are many cycles around us: the day and night cycles, the seasons' cycles, the solstice and equinox cycles, the moon cycle, yearly cycles, and so on. You have to learn to work with and be in harmony with these cycles. For example, it would be better to plant your crop in the spring than in the winter....you could plant in the winter, but the winter

conditions would make it harder for the crop to grow. Why be out of sync with the rhythm?

When you deal with rhythm, your outcome is equal to the effort that you put in. For example, if you go to the gym and work out every day, you would get stronger than if you were going once a month.

SECTION 5: CONCLUDING THE UNIVERSAL CODES

The Universal Codes is the basis for dealing with this matrix-time/space continuum reality. All other principles and laws are subgroups of The Universal Codes or fall under it. It is not saying that you cannot overcome this matrix reality, but it is giving you the construct to better deal with the matrix while you are in it.

No matter what games you play or the things that you participate in, there are always rules, guidelines, or principles to go by....otherwise, it would be chaos and nothing would get done or make sense. If you are going to participate in something, it is good to at least know what you are dealing with. Sometimes, you can take principles and use them to your advantage. The Universal Codes is the guideline for this matrix reality.

The key is to make The Universal Codes relevant to everyday life and to show how they can be applied in a practical way.

SECTION 6: GEEDOLOGY

Because energy is in constant movement and everything and everyone is energy, then people must be constantly moving, that is, *growing, evolving, expanding, and developing (GEED)*....that is what keeps your life force going in this reality—GEEDology. Most people realize that

they must grow and put a lot of effort into reaching their goals and objectives. However, they do not always get the maximum benefit because they focus on one aspect of themselves versus the whole or complete self. The aspects that must be developed are the subjective, the physical, the emotional, and the mental (**SPEEM**).

SECTION 7: SPEEMOLOGY / PEEMOLOGY

PEEMology or SPEEMology is the concept that everything and everyone has a *Physical, Emotional, Energetic, and Mental aspect* (PEEM) or Subjective, Physical, Emotional, Economical, and Mental aspect (SPEEM), in which all aspects work in a holistic way. Being aware of all the aspects and dealing with them together as a whole and not separately will create a stronger foundation for someone to expand on.

Most people realize that they must grow and put a lot of effort into reaching their goals and objectives. However, they do not always get the maximum benefit because they focus on one aspect of themselves rather than the whole or complete self. The aspects that must be considered in developing are the subjective, the physical, the emotional, and the mental. Everyone and everything has these aspects that work holistically, and they must be in sync, or the outcome is only as strong as the weakest aspect. That is why they say that a chain is only as strong as its weakest link. Some people might work on their mental or physical body but not their other aspects that bring them down or an organization might work on its physical and mental parts and not realize the subjective and emotional parts are lacking.

Now that you are aware of SPEEM, let us get a general understanding of each aspect separately:

SECTION 8:

ENERGETIC/SUBJECTIVE

Perception, creative, imaginative, visualization, intuition, fantasy,

The energy field will deal with the unseen. These are things that have an impact on us, but they are not tangible, so they are overlooked. This would include the subjective body, the etheric, the collective conscious, and anything that is beyond the five senses.

PHYSICAL

The material world

The physical is about things at the material level—the body, resources, and structures. That is health, exercise, diet, clothing, shelter, and anything that is tangible.

EMOTIONAL

The feelings

The emotional aspect is about desires, behavior, love, drive, ambitions, instincts, motivations, and anything of the kind.

ECONOMICAL

The flow of value

Economical is in regard to the energy for interacting with others; the system for rewarding; the thing that motivates; self-worth; the energy of worth; and financial resources.

MENTAL

The intellect

The mental concern is with the mind, knowledge, information, thinking, goals, creativity, mentality, and wisdom.
