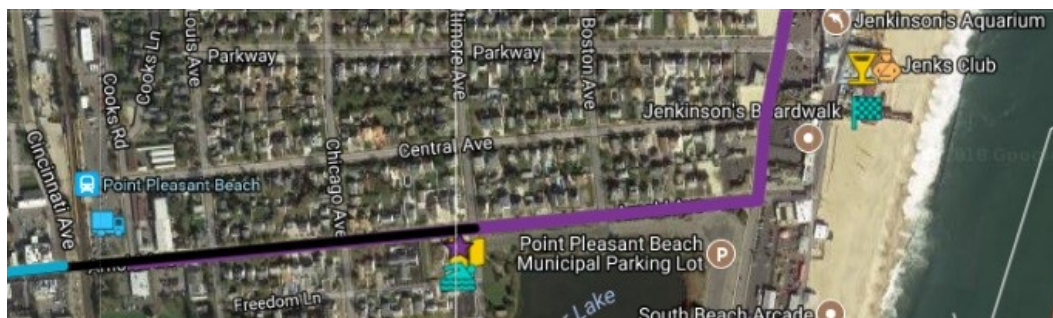

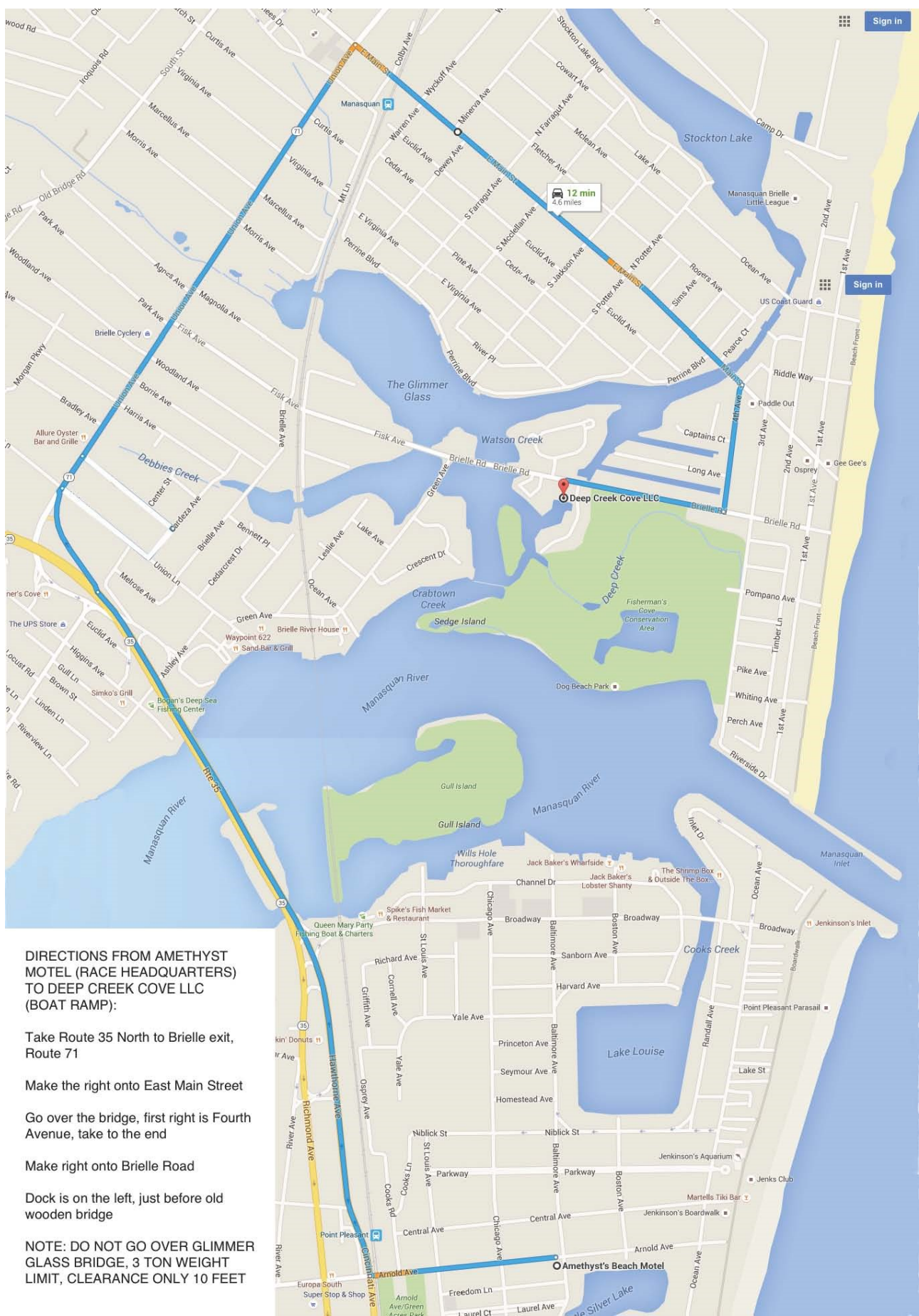

The State of New Jersey Helmet Law

No person shall operate or ride upon any motorcycle or motor scooter upon the public roads or highways of this state unless such person is wearing on his or her head a crash helmet of the type and design inspected and approved by the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators. Only registered licensed vehicles are permitted on the roadways

Bar-B-Que's are NOT permitted in the Dry Pits at the Point Pleasant Beach Train Station.
