

COVID-19 ALERT

The State of Illinois and the U.S. government has determined that chiropractic services are essential, since data from large insurers has demonstrated that chiropractic patients have substantially lower rates of hospitalization as compared to those who do not utilize chiropractic services.(1,2)

As a result, our office is open to serve your chiropractic health care needs.

During this time, however, we have restricted our hours through May 2nd. Our hours will be:

TUESDAY	9:30 am - NOON & 2:00pm to 6:00pm.
WEDNESDAY	9:30 am - NOON & 2:00pm to 6:00pm.
THURSDAY	9:30 am - NOON & 2:00pm to 6:00pm.

In addition, we have restricted patients to one per fifteen minute time slot and screening questions (history of recent fever, cough, shortness of breath, recent pink eye infection, recent loss of sense of smell or taste) are employed. Patients' temperature is taken with an infrared thermometer prior to treatment. Anyone who fails the screening questions or has a fever are asked to leave the premises and reschedule their appointment after seeking advice from their primary care physician.
